BUSINESS AND POLITICS.

Probably no native of Prince Edward Island resident in Canada ministers in ideas to so wide a constituency as Dr. Andrew MacPhail, or is so much quoted, and yet few, if any can agree with all that he says and writes.

His fruitful and energetic mind is directed to many topics in quick succession. One of his later deliveries was made the other day before the Canadian Club of Montreal and dealt with Business and Politics.

Here are a few extracts therefrom which will bear thinking over:

"What is needed in all democratic communities is an assembly entirely composed of men who make politics a profession, as Sir Wilfrid Laurier and Mr. Borden do—men of leisure and contemplative minds, who are not especially concerned about business, about a living, or at all about becoming rich.

"Public affairs are not as simple as they seem. Knowledge and wisdom are only a little less necessary than probity and a nice sense of honor."

"The fallacy that a business man has a special aptitude for politics arises from a confusion of mind about the legislative and administrative functions of the government.

If the demand for business men in politics were carried on it would mean that you would get neither those business men who have enlarged minds nor legislators who have at heart the public good.

The men who project large enterprises have their own affairs to attend to. They have too much sense to engage in public affairs for which they have no special aptitude.

Business men will be apt to treat the people as employees. Experience as a trader does not necessarily tend towards the enlargement of mind which is necessary for dealing with questions in abstract.

of the United States affords the best illustration the world has yet known of government by business men. When Mr. Lorimer wanted a seat in the Senate he bought it in the market, and a man who buys the people will sell them again. When the insurance companies of New York required legislation, they bought it. When corporations feel the need of protection, they contribute to campaign funds. They have even bartered with justice.

"Engagement in business does not necessarily create wisdom, but on the contrary, 'He that hath little business shall become wise.'"

The subject would be a good one for the debating societies to discuss during the winter evenings to come. There is much that might be said upon both sides. To many it might seem that the right government of the country is largely a business proposition and that a good business training is a prime requisite for usefulness in public life.

Surely not all who have little business become wise. Nor are the men of leisure, as a class, the men of contemplative minds. And there are few of the professional politicians who attain the status and usefulness of the great party leaders.

It may be doubted whether the House of Commons as it is today would not be improved by the substitution of business men for a large proportion of the ninety-odd lawyers and doctors now holding seats in that body.

In any case the leisured class in this country is too small from which to select our representatives in Parliament. One trouble with a majority of elected representatives appears to be that they do not sufficiently acquaint themselves with public affairs, or energetically endeavor to make themselves of real use to the country, resting content with following their party leaders and looking after good offices for themselves.

As these duties bear very heavily upon the people of Prince Edward Island, it becomes of interest to learn whether a Conservative victory in Canada would mean a reduction of duties here. Perhaps The Examiner will tell us.
