HISTORY OF CANADA.—J. A. O. Ethier, M. P., for Two Mountains, Que., recently made a query in the House of Commons, Ottawa, in connection with an official history of Canada. He was informed by Mr. Cadogan, the newly appointed Secretary of State, that "by a Commission dated Nov. 9th, 1912, Sir Joseph Pope, K. C. M. G., and E. F. Jarvis and A. G. Doughty were appointed Commissioners for the purpose of an investigation with respect to the records of the different Departments of the Government of Canada, with a view to ascertaining their nature and extent and their state of preservation, the use made of them in conducting public business, the state of the buildings where in such buildings were deposited, the space they occupy, the facilities of access thereto by such departments and by the public and the control exercised over such records."
