# IN FULL BLAST AGAIN

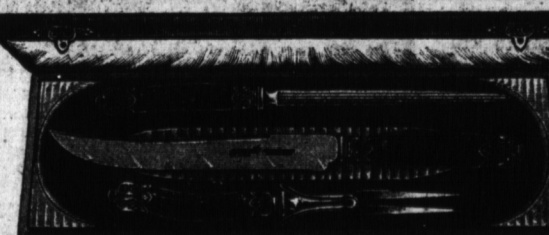
