Bathurst will play here on Friday night, Jack Brown of Moncton or Jack Twaddle of Amherst will referee.

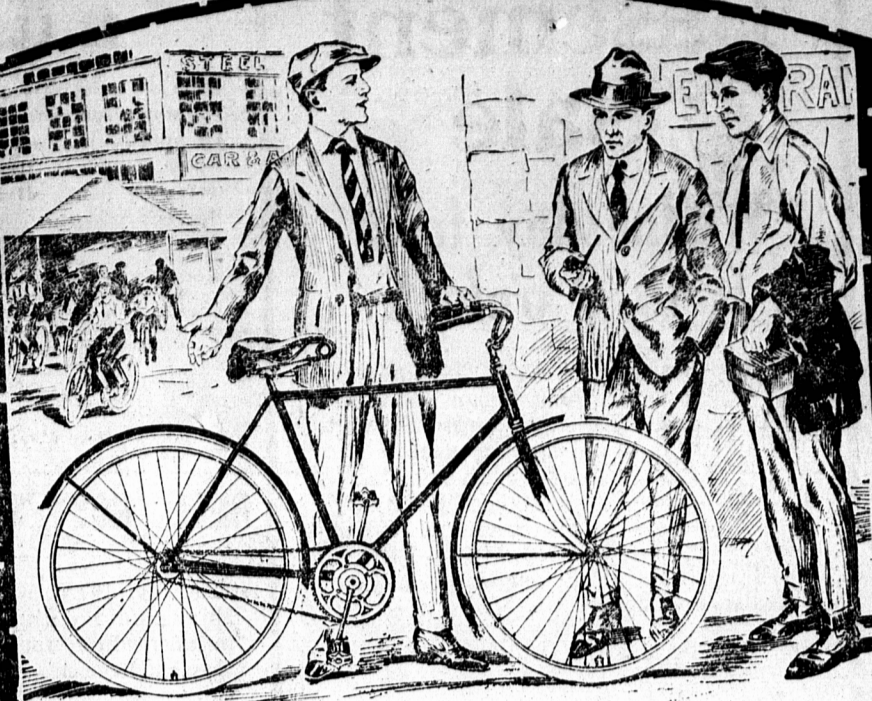

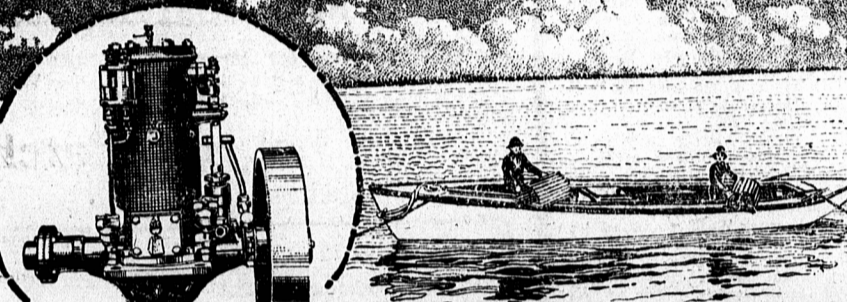

On motion the financial report was adopted.

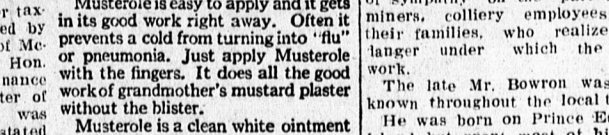

Mr. A. E. Ackland King's Printer

OTTAWA, April 1—Charges are imminent in the Dominion department of Labor and the department of public printing. It is understood Mr. F. A. Ackland who has been Deputy Minister of Labor more than fourteen years will relinquish that post, it is learned from a usually well informed source and will be succeeded by a prominent Montreal labor man. Mr. Ackland is to become King's printer in fact as well as law and is expected to enter upon the duties of that office on Tuesday.

Mr. Ackland has been titular King's printer for some time but of course drew salary only as Deputy Minister of Labor. In fact since Mr. Tachere retired from office of King's printer to become one of the Liberatorians of parliament there has been no official who held that office alone when Mr. Tachere resigned. It was proposed that office be abolished, but it was found, however, that the statute respecting public printing as it stood required that there be a King's printer. WANTS INCOME TAX REDUCED

OTTAWA, April 1—Asking that corporation and individuals contributing to education and charitable institutions be permitted to deduct the amount of such contributions from gross income for taxation.

A delegation headed by Sir Arthur Currie, president of McGill University, waited upon Hon. W. S. Fielding, Minister of Finance and Sir Louper Gouin, Minister of Justice. The delegation was heard in private, but it was stated after the hearing that it had represented to the ministers that the United States allows a 15 percent reduction on the income of an individual for contributions to charitable and educational institutions. A similar exemption was suggested for Canada. Mr. Fielding promised consideration.
