I haven't got the parcels yet but they always take a few days longer to get here than a letter, so I may get them any day now, and you bet I will appreciate them. A person sure likes a change once in a while from the army rations. I suppose the sun is beginning to shine on both sides of the fence now, and the snow will be getting soft and slushy, it is nice and warm here since we had our little snow storm. I don't think there will be much more cold weather now. I suppose you get all kinds of rumors and war stories down there but you can't beat this place for rumors. We have a new one every day about moving or something. There isn't much to write about I am well and healthy. Give my love to all.

Dear Mother—I have just received your second parcel and it was certainly welcome. It arrived on Sunday morning when I had lots of time to enjoy it. The cookies and cake were certainly fine. I suppose the snow is nearly all gone now. It will soon be my birthday. Last year I lost track of it till the next day I am getting old alright. I'm almost twenty-three, but perhaps will be back in Canada for my next. Has the Island Regiment recruited yet? I see by the papers that Nova Scotia is doing a big stroke of recruiting now. Well mother dear I must close now. Good-bye with lots of love

INSPECTION OF PRINCE OF WALES COLLEGE CADET CORPS

Capt. R. Robinson Black, O. and I. C. C., 6th Division, made the annual inspection of the Prince of Wales College Cadet Corps, under the instruction of Lieut. J. A. Murphy and Lieut. W. T. Dawson on the college grounds Friday afternoon. The Captain of the Cadet Corps, Prov. Lieut. J. W. Godfrey, was in command, having come over for the purpose from the Royal School of Infantry, Halifax. The various movements were well performed, and included the march past, company drill, physical exercise, extended order work and squad drill under the platoon commanders. At the close of the inspection Capt. Black made the members of the corps an address which was very well received, and expressed himself as well pleased with the efficiency of the college unit. It is pleasing to note from St. John reports that Capt. Black is meeting with uniform success in the organization of corps in schools where such have not previously been attempted. As a connecting link, through the school, between military and civil life the organizer of Cadet Corps deserves and doubtless will receive every encouragement from the educational authorities.
