## AROUND THE FOX EXCHANGE

A Boston correspondent writes: Interest in the fox business in and around Boston is growing fast and financial men, who a few months ago scoffed at the industry, are now asking questions. In one instance, the president and treasurer of a State Deposit Trust Company, have organized a \$250,000 Massachusetts Corporation and given an order for five pairs of silver black foxes. This company will ranch in Maine. In Massachusetts, another company, the Colonial Fur Ranch Co., incorporated for \$150,000—\$60,000 worth of stock already subscribed for—has placed an order for fifty pair of patch foxes. This company will ranch on Prince Edward Island. It will be seen from this that things are stirring around Boston, and if financial conditions do not encounter some unexpected set-back, there will be considerable Boston money going into the fox industry this year.

The prospectus of "The John Agnew Fur Farms, Ltd.," has been issued. There was some delay in producing it, but this was due to a circumstance which is gratifying—pressure of business at the printers. It is an exceedingly well got up booklet, and splendidly sets the fox industry forth in attractive light. The cover makes a striking display with a small reproduction of the map of Prince Edward Island which is described as "The world's greatest fur farm, the home of the domesticated silver black fox, the happy medium between the two temperature extremes, where the most costly pelts known to commerce are produced."

The fox business continues to boom. Within the last week the Royal Investment Exchange received orders for fox stock from London, Alberta and California in regard to the last mentioned the commission being to the extent of \$4,000.

The Royal Investment Exchange has now made definite arrangements for opening a branch office in English River, Ontario. The office will be situated in London, Ontario, of course. There all information regarding the silver black fox industry will be available. The office will be opened for business by the middle of May.

The Provincial Fox Company reports unusually promising prospects for an excellent year.

Mr. Fred B. McRae, of the Connaught Pedigreed Foxes, Ltd., leaves this morning en route to Boston and New York on business in connection with this company.

Reports from the ranches as to the progress of the season of increase still come along and on the whole they make the prospect for fox stock-holders look exceedingly rosy.

One company that is working with five pairs of silver blacks is reported to have four litters already, and with every prospect of a fifth. One litter contains seven pups.

The raising of fisher and mink is proving a great success, on the testimony of people who have placed these animals in captivity. Heretofore the fisher was supposed to be of a very nervous disposition, but it has been found that when it is placed in confinement it becomes very docile; and the number of litters reported so far this spring has given to ranchers much encouragement and gratification. It is known that one rancher in New Brunswick has sold all his young fisher this spring at \$500 a pair.

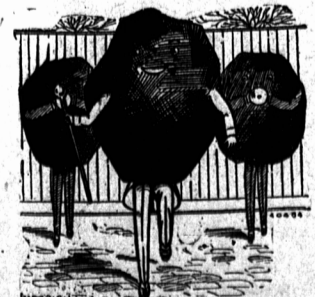
