A BIG CIGAR BILL.

The cigar bill of the American people last year, was \$346,000,000. For the fiscal year ending Jun 30th, 1902, according to the report recently issued by the United States Commissioner of Inland Revenue, 6,905,749,968 cigars were consumed in that country. That was nearly 10,000,000 cigars for every day in the 365 days of the year. This does not include the 2,668,176,130 cigarettes, nor the upwards of \$15,000,000 pounds of snuff and tobacco consumed. The revenue collected on all this by the Government is over \$70,000,000, and is on the increase. In fact, the income increases faster than the population itself.

APANESE AND WHITES ONE.

VANCOUVER, B. C., May 7.—The Japanese Union have advised the Japanese not to fish on the Fraser River, as the offer of the canner, of twelve cents a fish, or a sliding scale as last year, will not be accepted. White fishmen have also declined the same offer, but are trying to make better terms.
