Islander Helps To Build Church

The Press-Telegram, Long Beach, California, telegraphed a page of its January 10th issue to a description of the city's newly completed Second Church of Christ, Scientist; which it calls, a triumph of graceful art, at once dignified and imposing, and with no attempt at ornamentation.

The structure is of Corinthian architecture and is perfectly proportioned. Its length being 150 feet, width 75, and extreme height above the street level, 80 feet. It is constructed entirely of concrete, finished inside and out, in gridded and moulded plaster, which the exterior is a perfect facsimile of cut limestone, while the interior is decorated with friezes and wood wainscoting effects.

The main auditorium on the second floor is unparalleled except at the rear, the ceiling being supported by a huge steel beam. This hall will seat 2,000 persons and its acoustics are perfect, a cork floor deadening all sound and special devices in ceiling and sides making the human voice audible in all parts of the room.

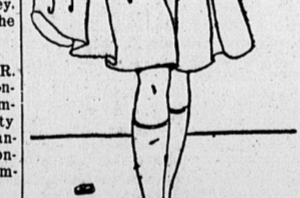

STATES PUBLIC OWNERSHIP OF CAN. NATIONAL A SUCCESS

Hon. J. J. Hughes, Liberal, Tells of Operation of Most of Railroads in Dominion By Government

The greatest public ownership experiment in the world, the Canadian National Railways, is an assured success, and will never be abandoned, in the opinion of Hon. James J. Hughes, Liberal member of the Canadian Government, in King's County, P. E. I., who is in Boston today and will address the Intercolonial Club this evening.

Everybody agrees that the success of the experiment is due in large measure to the wise and patriotic service of Sir Henry Thornton, who was born in the States and has the greatest training in Government ownership as the manager of the English Railways during the war.

Under his management the Canadian National Railways have shown tremendous improvement in all kinds of service—freight, passenger and express. The deficit, or the difference between earnings and expenditures, has been steadily reduced until it is now within controllable dimensions. We are sure it will be completely wiped out.

Opposition Weaker "I think the Canadian people," he continued, "are justified in their sense of pride in Canada, at least we feel that we have exploited the myth that Government ownership cannot work. The Canadian National Railways have passed beyond the experimental stage and the opposition has grown steadily weaker."

Public Debt Reduced "But we were determined to take care of the surviving soldiers and the dependents of those who fell. We are discharging that obligation, and do not intend to relax our efforts. Meanwhile, in the last three years we have reduced our expenditures and taxes, and have slightly reduced our public debt. Perhaps the best index of our steady progress is found in the fact that three years ago our money was at a considerable discount, while today it is at par. This clearly indicates how we are regarded by the banks and large financial houses of the great republic to the south of us."

MIND AND SPIRIT neither can produce music without the other. But in authority there is a difference. If the organ should do as it pleases it might make a noise, but not music.
