HOW ITALY IS WAGING WAR ON THE CAMORRA

VIRTEBO, Italy, March 7.—The voluminous documents with the aid of which the Government hopes to convict Enrico Alfano and forty of his associates of murder, and thus rid Italy of leading spirits in the dreaded Camorra, reveal that Gennaro Cuocolo and his wife, "The beautiful Sorrentine," the killing of whom led to the round-up of their band, had romantic but far from worthy careers.

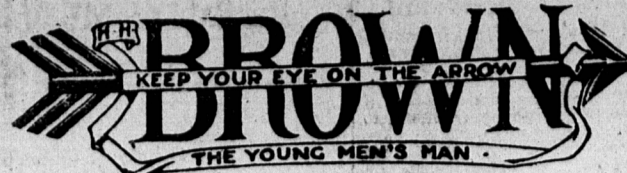
A part of the story which will be laid bare when the trial starts on March 11 may now be told. Cuocolo and his wife were 42 years old. They lived in the Via Nardones, in the centre of the city only a few steps from the royal palace, in a pretty fourth floor apartment. Here after the discovery of Cuocolo's body at Torre del Greco, the police found the lifeless form of his wife. It was stretched upon the bed and the pink silk nightgown was perforated with numerous wounds. Among them was the characteristic dagger cut, known as the Fregio, the circular wound given to one who has broken an oath. It inflicted upon an honest woman or a girl it is made by a slash on the cheek, but if given to a woman of doubtful character it is always upon the body. In the case of Maria Cutilini Cuocolo the assassin left the mark of the evil.

Cuocolo in his youth, it developed, had been condemned for theft, swindling and other offences. For ten or twelve years before his death, however, he had been before the authorities and apparently had become respectable. He was accustomed to define his situation by saying: "Even if I have married a beautiful woman of not illiberal habits, I am content, as she is a faithful wife, and, anyway, my marriage was the result of a vow. At the age of thirty years I was ill of a terrible disease, and vowed to San Gennaro, my patron, if I recovered to rescue some unfortunate woman from sin and make her my wife. San Gennaro heard my prayer and I have kept my word. Since then I have been tranquil and home-loving and only once resorted to compromising myself, when in public in the Galleria Umberto I boxed the ears of Enrico Alfano—called Erricone."

This boast of Cuocolo gave the first clue to the alleged instigator of his death. The story reached the ears of a clever detective, one Ippolino, and led him to investigate whether the murders might not have been due to the hatred of Erricone and his companions. It was established that Erricone, who is no coward, feared Cuocolo and had sworn a vendetta against him. Erricone denied that Cuocolo had struck him and swore that he had not even known the murdered man. Nevertheless, the police persisted on this clue and it developed that instead of mending his ways, Cuocolo was in full active service in the Camorra, however, limiting himself to two departments of crime, that of organizing thefts and taking the lion's share of all operations.

Both he and his wife had fame among criminals as clever organizers. At the same time there are papers in the police archives which show that on various occasions they acted as police spies. In fact notes written in pencil have been found in which the two denounced thefts and crimes arranged by persons affiliated with the Camorra. These papers which the police had thought were kept absolutely secret were kept absolutely secret by the Camorra and were the cause of suspicion of the Cuocolos and of hatred against them on the part of those who were denounced and apprehended.

Having established the double dealings of Cuocolo, as a brigand and a police spy, the police went about to
