 NEW YORK, Dec. 19—(AP)—An assessment of specialties put on a rally of their own in today's stock market while leaders bogged down under further year-end tax selling. Early efforts at recovery by most pivotal issues were unsuccessful.
 Transfers amounted to 751,750 shares against 718,840 yesterday. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was off 2 of a point at 50.6. In the Canadian group Bell Telephone fell back 2 3-4 points to 125 1-4 while Distillers Seagram, McIntyre and Hollinger registered minor gains. International Nickel, Ford and Lake Shore were easy.
 Stocks on the minus side were U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, Chrysler, Montgomery Ward, Johns-Manville, Anaconda, Kennecott, Western Union, N. Y. Central, Great Northern, Standard Oil of N. J., Loews and International Harvester. Among the gainers were International Paper preferred, which hit a new 1939 peak; Westinghouse; Dow Chemical, Celanese, Philip Morris, Sears Roebuck, American Telephone and General Motors.

GRAIN

CHICAGO, Dec. 19—(AP)—The upward rush of wheat prices, which since Nov. 28 had added about 22 cents a bushel to market quotations, was halted today by heavy profit-taking but not without the most violent fluctuations in recent years. Prices collapsed 4 1-4 to 7-8 cents but rallied immediately and after midsession gained as much as 5 1-8 from early lows. This put May and July contracts up to \$1.09 3-4 and \$1.57 5-8, new high for the season, and December to \$1.11 1-2, within 1-4 of the two-year peak established yesterday.
 Another burst of selling in the final hour caused wheat to close 2 3-4 to 3 1-4 cents lower than yesterday. Dec \$1.08 1-2 to 3-8. May \$1.06 to 1-4 and July \$1.04 3-8 to 1-8. Corn finished unchanged to 1-2 higher, Dec 57 1-8. May 59 5-8 to 1-2. Oats unchanged to 1-4 lower and rye 2-3 3-8 down.
