**Record Holstein Show At Toronto**

Upsets featured the Holstein exhibit at the Royal where both of last years Grand Champions were defeated and an unheralded entry from Eastern Ontario won the Inter-Provincial Herd Competition. This was the largest Holstein show yet held at the Royal with 331 head exhibited by 83 breeders from Canada and U. S. A. Paul Misner, Hulmeville, Pa. Judge.

Resuming last years "battle of the bulls" 12 entries were shown in the Aged Bull class. "Marksman", owned by J. J. McCague, Ontario, and the present owner, Allan and G. J. Cerswell, Beeton, who was defeated in 1946 by Chip, owned by Franlo Farms, Hopkins, Minn. turned the tables this time and then went on to take the Grand Championship. His son, "Libert" was named Reserve Grand Champion after heading the two-year-olds. Alert recently topped the All-Canadian Bull Sale at \$11,800 going from R. H. McLaughlin, Lanark and J. J. E. McCague, Alliston, Ont. to Rodolfo "Sovereign", owned by T. R. Dent and Clark E. Brown, Woodstock, was third. Glenvue Noelle Inka, bred by D. S. Duntion, Brampton, Ont. and now owned by Bolano Rios of Druryway beat last year's Grand Champion Rosehill Payne Wayne in the milking Aged Cow class. These two cows then went on to the Grand and Reserve Grand Championships. "Rosehill" took the Grand Championship in 1946 for J. D. Innes, Woodstock, Ont. and was then sold to her present owner Franlo Farms. Junior Champion bull was Spring Farm Sovereign Supreme, a son of "Sovereign" owned by J. M. G. W. and W. D. Fraser, Streetsville, was an outstanding Junior
