Method 1. Place ham on a rack in a covered roaster. Pour 2 cups water around the meat. Bake in 325 deg. F. oven for 2 1/2 to 3 hours per pound for hams weighing 6 pounds or over. For smaller hams allow 30 minutes per pound. Remove rind. Cover ham with a mixture of equal parts of brown sugar and sifted bread crumbs and a very little dry mustard. Stick whole cloves in the ham to form a pattern and return to a 400 deg. F. oven to brown the topping without water. Allow about 20 to 30 minutes for this.

MIX FOR A GLAZED TOPPING Mix brown sugar and a very little mustard with fruit juice or cider or with water and a little vinegar. Baste the cooked and prepared ham with this baking at 400 deg. F. till the ham is nicely glazed. Ham may be glazed with honey.

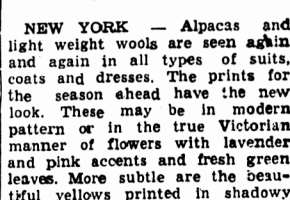
SECOND METHOD OF BAKING HAM Wrap ham in heavy wrappings paper; place fat side up in an open shallow pan on a rack. Do not add water. Use times and temperatures given in Method 1.

GLAZED APPLES WITH HAM Half 3 or 4 medium sized apples. Remove stem, blossom end and cores. Place skin side down in shallow baking pan. Sprinkle apples with brown sugar and a little melted butter. Add a little water to pan. Bake till tender in a moderate oven. Cool and fill centres with jelly. Or cook peeled apple slices in sugar syrup flavored with cinnamon stick and colored with red food coloring.

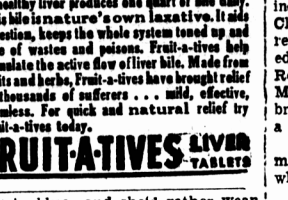

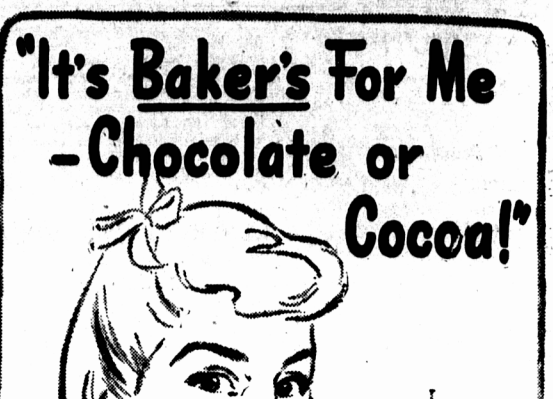

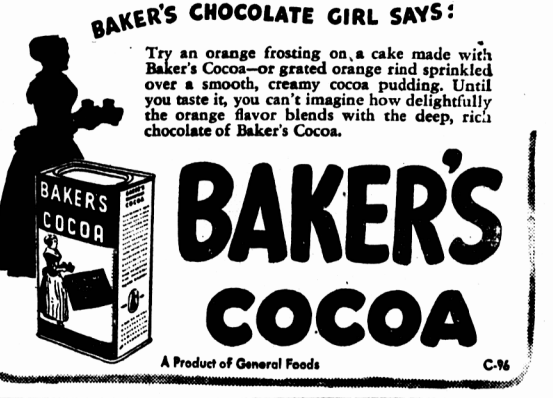
