SUMMERSIDE BOARD OF TRADE

(Special by Phone.)

SUMMERSIDE, March 24.— A special meeting of the council of the Summerside Board of Trade was held in the Council Chambers Monday evening and was well attended. After some routine business the secretary read a number of communications among them being one of Hon Donald Nicholson, M.P., re the provincial steamship lines between the Island and the Mainland in which he stated that he had waited upon the Minister of Trade and Commerce re this matter and insisted that Summerside be made an equal port with Charlottetown, provided a subsidy was granted. The matter of petitioning the local government for a rebate to the town of one half of the Income Tax collected here was discussed at length and most of the speakers were in favor of rebating but no definite action was taken. Re the petitioning of the Dominion Government to have a town clock installed on the government building, now that the alterations are being made was discussed and a resolution to petition the government to have a suitable clock installed was unanimously adopted. It was decided to hold a general meeting of the Board on April 8 to take up fully the matter of Railway improvements in order that this question may be taken up fully with Mr. Hayes of the I. C. R. when he visits the Island later on. Other questions of minor importance were discussed but no definite action taken, after which the Board adjourned.—J.

THE TYPHOID CAMPAIGN.

As spring approaches a vast army marshalls its cohorts to "swat the fly" in the perennial campaign against typhoid fever.

The fact is now quite generally recognized that the common fly is directly responsible for a large amount of this infection. Typhoid fever is a bacterial disease of the human alimentary canal and can spread only through sewage. Therefore the first attack should consist in destroying the germs in the sewage.

The best means for sewage disposal is the septic tank, in which the sewage is held until it decays. The process of decay destroys the typhoid germs.—B. Friess, Colorado Agricultural College.

HOW TO SAVE STEPS

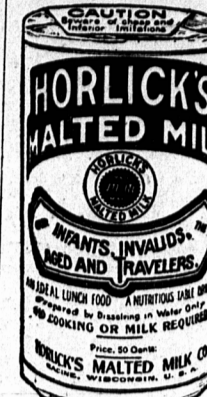
