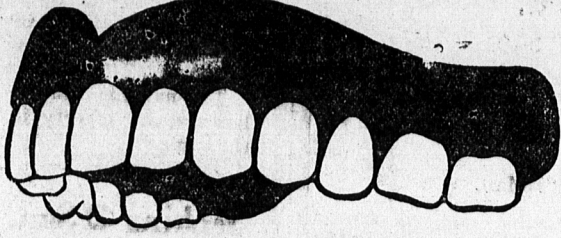

A MATTER OF ECONOMY.

If the thousand and one thing about the house that makes money go fast—the little things that don't seem to count—were bunched together in one, it would not be so difficult to stop the leak. But they are usually such trivial things that it takes more than a sharp and ever-watchful eye to keep expenses down.

If we had time to compare one brand with another, some housewife's leaks would be avoided, and some household tempers would disappear. There is a big difference in flour. Some flour turns out a perfect baking, seems to do equally well for bread and pastry.
