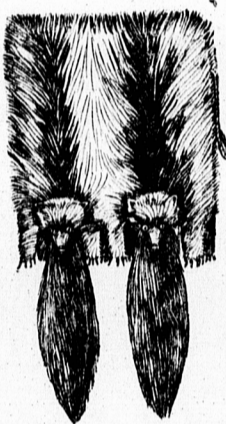

AN ADDRESS AND

KINKORA, Nov. 9. — On last Saturday evening, just previous to their departure for Denver, Colorado, Arthur S. and Mrs. Murphy, Kinkora, were waited upon by their neighbors and friends and presented with an address and suitable gifts.

The following is the address which was read by Dr. W. J. MacMillan.

To Arthur S. and Mrs. Murphy: Dear Friends:—It is with feelings of the deepest regret that we learn of your intended departure from our midst. You, sir, have been one of the pioneer residents of Kinkora, and began your career with very little of this world's goods at your disposal.

but by your industry, sobriety and perseverance, you have made for yourself a comfortable home, of which any farmer might well be proud. Not only have you been a first class farmer, but also a man, whose example is well worthy of imitation by everyone. Those who lived nearest you will always regret the loss of a kind neighbor, one, who was ever ready to help a fellow being in distress. Your ideals of morality were ever of the highest and you can truthfully say that you carried them into practice and it was well known that your word was your bond. Every movement that tended to advance the interests of the community or the welfare of your neighbors, always found in you an earnest advocate.

As a devout Christian gentleman, your influence for good upon the rising generation cannot be too highly estimated, and all found you a firm friend, a wise counsellor in difficulty and one whom it was always a pleasure to meet. These words apply with as much truth to respected wife for Mrs. Murphy will always be regarded as a noble example of a high minded woman. We are all extremely sorry that circumstances make it necessary for you to depart from our midst and follow the ever increasing tide to the West. The people of this province always regret to see citizens like Mrs. Murphy and yourself departing from our fair island and we find poor consolation in the fact that our loss is someone else's gain.

In saying "Farewell" to you, we shall ever pray that God may shower down His choicest blessings upon you and shall always be glad to hear of your continued success. In conclusion we ask you to accept this cane and Mrs. Murphy this writing desk not for their intrinsic values but as a slight token of the esteem in which you are both held. SANKEY'S VOICE IN FAMOUS HYMNS

NEW YORK, Nov. 10.—The voice of Ira D. Sankey, the evangelist and hymn writer, who died last summer, was heard by phonograph last night in the Simpson M. E. Church, Cermont and Willoughby avenues, Brooklyn. A large audience strangely thrilled, listened to the several Sankey hymns which were photographed a short time before his death.

The Rev. Wm. J. Thompson, pastor of the Church, presided at the services. Charles Rowsell, a friend of Mr. Sankey, gave a brief lecture and operated the phonograph, which was placed on the pulpit platform. Among the hymns recorded were "The Ninety in Nine; Hiding in Thee; There is No Dark Valley, and Jesus of Nazareth is Passing By."

Mr. Sankey was interested in the Sankey M. E. Church and had a wish that it should be one of the first to have a public hearing of the records.

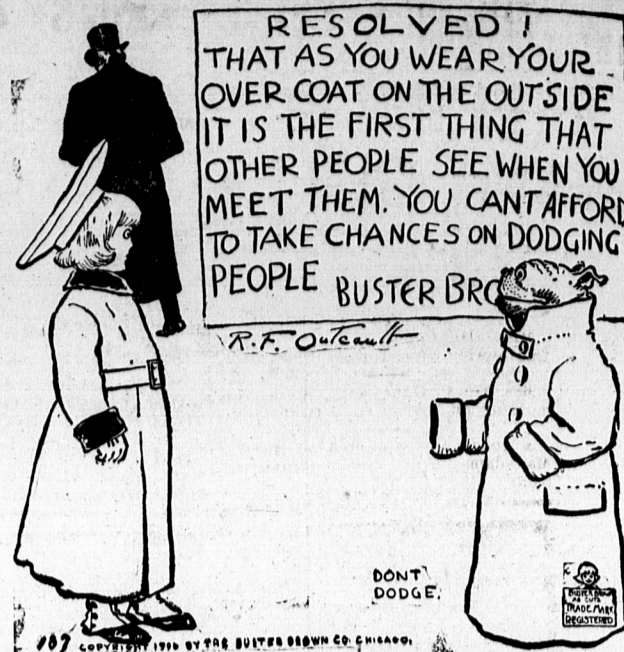

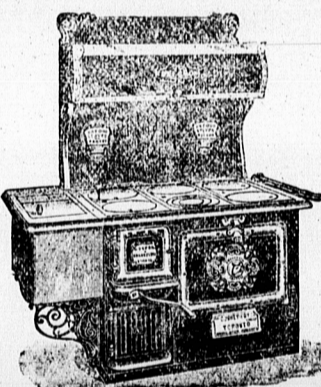
