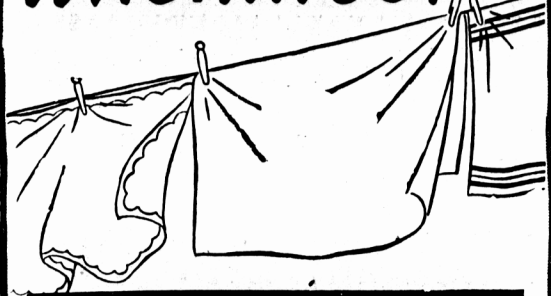

Rose of Sharon is just beginning to bloom and will continue until heavy frost, this late blooming makes it very valuable in the garden as almost all our shrubs are Spring and early Summer bloomers.

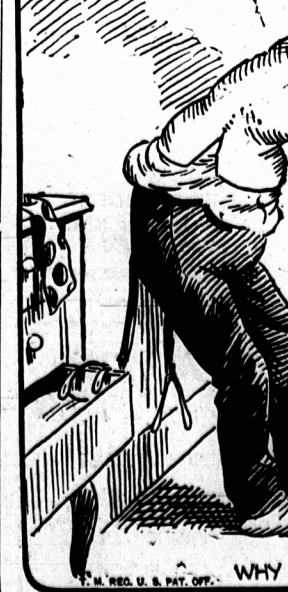
I have seen some wonderful Hydrangea shrubs in gardens as I drive along the road, and there are many beautiful new varieties. I have a small bush of the old Paniculata and must try to improve it by moving to another location.

In thinking over some of the more beautiful combinations of flowers this Summer I think of the Pale Pink New Dawn Climbing Rose that pushed through the white lattice fence with Sweet William in a deeper shade as a ground cover and white fragrant Feverfew as a contrast.

A most beautiful long-spurred Columbine in blue and white with yellow Violas, and I have many more to transplant from seed sown this Spring. They are very beautiful as cut flowers, looking especially well in slender glass vases.
