DEADLY D-SEASE AMONG CATTLE

YELLOW PERIL IS A NIGHTMARE

LONDON, November 17.—The Tokio correspondent of the Daily Telegraph says that the Japanese authorities and newspapers ridicule the theory fostered in Europe that China is awakening to such an extent as to become a menace. BOWMANVILLE, Ont., Nov. 16.—Considerable excitement has been created among the farmers of West Twp., Durham County, over the outbreak of a deadly disease among the cattle of a family known as Blackie. Two valuable cows belonging to the head of Monday Bca., of this town, have died, and another has suspicious symptoms. Dr. F. H. S. Lowry, V. S., was called and pronounced the disease anthrax at once. Dr. Robert Young, the Dominion Veterinary Inspector, was notified and confirmed Dr. Lowry's diagnosis and ordered the animals buried to prevent the disease being communicated, and to take immediate action to have all other cattle vaccinated. The disease is new in this locality.
