DOG TRAINED TO PHONE—APPROACH OF ENEMY.

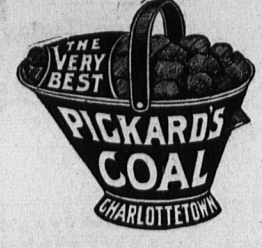
