SCOUTS WAR TALK OF AMERICAN JINGOES IN REGARD TO JAPAN.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 26—"There is not the slightest likelihood of any trouble with Japan any more than with any other country with which we have excellent relations of friendship."

This statement was made today by Secretary of State Knox, to a representative of the Associated Press, when shown copies of the press despatches from Tokio, indicating considerable discussion in Japan of reported utterances of Mr. Shaw, secretary of the treasury, and of General Bell, of alleged anti-Japanese expressions in San Francisco. The secretary expressed great surprise that notice should be taken of such trifles and he added:

"Mr. Shaw's speech was obviously nothing but an argument for ship subsidy and what General Bell said made no reference to trouble in the Far East and was quite evidently an ordinary argument for increased appropriations for the army. As for the San Francisco report, everybody knows that our immigration arrangement with Japan is working entirely satisfactorily. In spite of this, agitators will talk, no serious-minded person should be disturbed."
