THE MANITOBA LIQUOR ACT.

As has been frequently stated in these columns the Manitoba Prohibitory Law or Liquor Act as it is briefly entitled, is considerably more stringent than the Prohibition Act of P. E. Island, and this fact lends additional importance to the recent unanimous decision of the Privy Council holding it to be a constitutional act. The Liquor Act forbids the sale of any liquor within the Province, whether by wholesale or retail except for medicinal, sacramental or mechanical uses. The sale for these purposes is permitted only to be made by duly qualified and licensed druggists, who must register every sale, to whom sold and for what purpose. There are no vendors other than the druggists. Liquor cannot even be given away in any place whatsoever other than in the private dwelling place of the giver. It can be supplied for churches only to ministers.

The manufacture of liquor within the Province is not prohibited, but it must not be sold within the Province, except to druggists and only for medicinal, medicinal or sacramental use. The importation from outside the Province is not expressly prohibited, but the restrictions are such that it must not be sold in the Province except in the limited manner prescribed by the Act. An important feature is the right to search for liquors kept in contravention of the law. It is an offence to have liquor on any premises except a private dwelling house, the meaning of which is very rigidly defined, and excludes all hotels, boarding houses, shops, clubs, apartment flats and places of entertainment. And where liquor is found on any such interdicted premises the burden of proof rests upon the accused person to show that it is not kept for sale. This is a most important and stringent provision as under most other prohibitory laws the burden of proof rests with the complainant to establish that liquor is kept for sale.

The Act also provides for the inspection of liquor manufacturing premises and warehouses licensed by the Dominion Government within the Province. This was one of the points in regard to which it was contended that the law exceeded the powers of the Province. Besides the general question whether the Legislature of Manitoba had power to pass a Prohibitory Act, a number of questions were submitted as to the constitutionality of various sections of the Act. These dealt with the extent to which the Province could restrict inter provincial trade, or interfere with the manufacture under federal license, or could destroy the sources of federal revenue. They also raised the question of the right of the Hudson's Bay Company under its imperial charter, to sell liquors within the Province, and whether the Province could take away such right.

It will be remembered that the Act was

intended to come in force on 1st June last, but pending the decision of the courts its operation was suspended. The Court of King's Bench of Manitoba, unanimously decided that the law was beyond the powers of the Legislature to enact. The Judicial Committee have now with equal unanimity decided that the law is valid, and it will no doubt be put in operation when the present license term expires on 1st June next. The decision of the Court of last resort was made with the entire Act before it and may reasonably be accepted as establishing the just power of the Provincial Legislature to enact the whole of it. It therefore marks a most important era in the constitutional history of prohibition within the British Empire. It also prepares the way for our own Legislature to make our Prohibitory law much more stringent than it is, notably in regard to search for liquors kept for illegal sale.

These are times of alarmist rumors most of which are untrue. It is almost needless to say, and only for the information of our country readers we say it, that there is not now and has not been for many years past any case of smallpox in Charlottetown. And we hope, with the careful precautions being taken that there may not be any for years to come.

There has been an enormous development of cotton manufacturing in the Southern States in recent years, until now the South is a close competitor with the North in this line. Of 3,400,000 bales of cotton manufactured in the country last year 1,600,000 bales was manufactured in Southern mills, against 1,800,000 in Northern mills. The South has now 200 millions of dollars invested in the cotton spinning and weaving industry, as against 61 millions in 1890 and 21 millions in 1880. The cotton crop of the South last year reached a value of \$194,000,000 exclusive of \$80,000,000 for cotton seed. The South has entered upon a new era of prosperity since the abolition of slavery in which the cotton industry and the coal, iron and steel industries are very conspicuous features.


