The parting words "Thou too shalt rise."

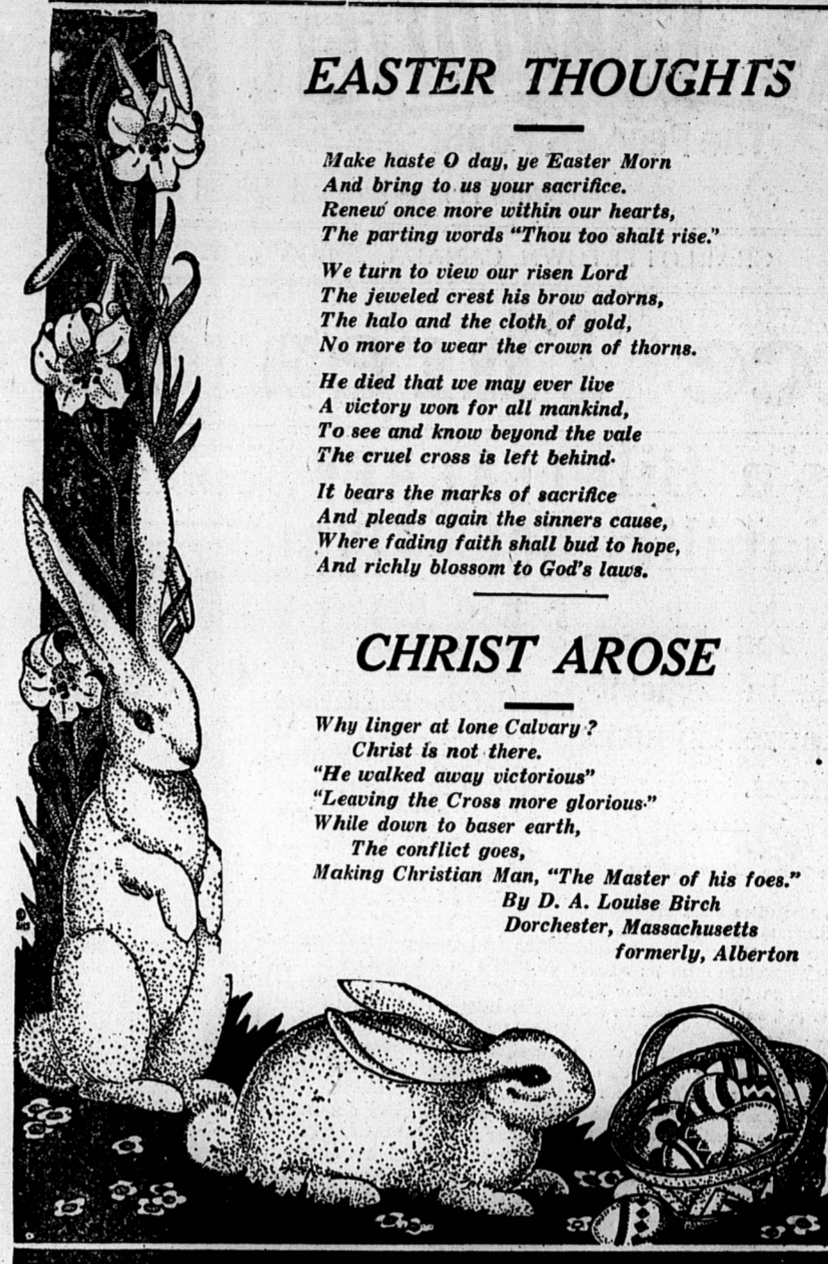
We turn to view our risen Lord

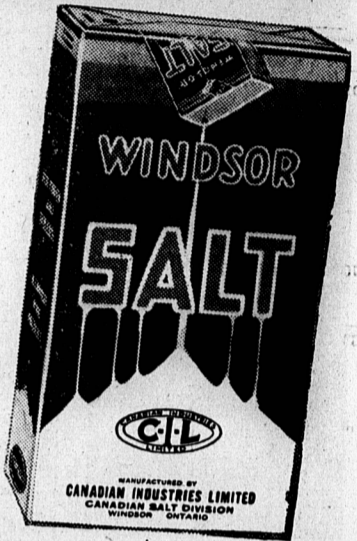
