Steels And Motors

NEW YORK, Jan. 3—(AP)—Late buying of steels and motors apparently sparked a selective recovery in today's stock market, although many leaders finished well on the downside.

Dealings fairly active on opening retreat, soon reverted to sluggishness as extreme losses returned to 2 or more points were reduced. While closing gains of fractions to a point or so were well distributed declines of as much as 5 persisted.

Canadian stocks were strong. Hiram Walker, up 1-2 at mid-day, spurred in late dealings to close 1-2 higher. Dome Mines gained 5-8. Distillers Seagrams 3-8 and Canadian Pacific 1-4. On the curb, Lake Shore added 1-4. Giant Yellowknife eased 1-8.

Schenley hit a new low for the last year but retrieved most of its loss to end off 1-4 at 50 3-8. Youngstown Sheet added 1-2 at 87. U. S. Steel 1-1/8 at 71 5-8. General Motors, 1-3/4 at 54. Chrysler 1-1/4 at 90 3-4. Phillip Morris 1-1/2 at 38 1-4 and Woolworth 1-1/4 at 48 1-4.

Ahead were Pennsylvania Railroad, Baltimore and Ohio, N. Y. Central, Bethlehem, Republic Steel, Montgomery Ward, United Aircraft, Consolidated Edison, Western Union "A", American Can, Westinghouse and International Nickel.

Dow Chemical and Park and Tilford yielded 5 and 1-4 points at 175 and 51 3-4 respectively. Santa Fe was off 1-1/4 at 97. Eastman Kodak 2 at 225, and U. S. Gypsum 2 1-4 at 91 1-4. Montreal Stock Prices Show Slight Decline

Trading was mainly selective and at the close minutes had a slight edge over pluses today in initial dealings for 1947 on the stock exchange and curb market following a two-day holiday recess. Utilities banks and golds were higher in the indices and industrials and papers lower.

On the downgrade for papers were Abitibi Common and Preferred, Consolidated, International and Price, while firmer were Bathurst and Dryden.

Bell and Gattineau improved and Shawinigan retrieved a slip in utilities while International Utilities and Beazlian were weaker. C. P. R. firmed in carriers and Commerce offset an early loss in banks. Nationale was down fractionally.

Liquor stocks paced the losers in industrials in sympathy with losses on the New York and Toronto markets. Behind were Seagrams, United Distillers, Alco "A" and "B", Walker and Canadian Breweries.

Canadian and Montreal Locomotives, Tar and The Voting Trust, Asbestos, D. Bridge and Cement were ahead and Chemicals, Sugar and Electrolux in retreat. Celanese was better and Bruck and D. Textiles in arrears in Textiles.

Base Metals were generally lower with Noranda, Nickel and Hudson Bay posting decreases. B. A. pushed higher. McColl overcame a slip and Petroleum stepped down in refineries.

Base Metals showed moderate improvement with O'Brien, Sullivan, East Sullivan, Golvive, Formaque, Buffadon, Central Cadillac and Stadacona winners.

U. S. ENTENTE "WAY TO WAR"

E. S. Crossman, above, a leader of the recent Labor rebellion in parliament against Foreign Secretary Bevin's foreign policy, appealed in a letter to the Times for a "clear" government statement that Britain is "in no wise committed to a military entente with the United States.
