James Wright, St John, N. B., Inspector of Government dredges, was among the detained passengers at Summerside and left yesterday by the 2:15 train for the E. S.

Thirteen tons of smelts shipped by James Morrison and three and a half tons butter shipped from the Dunk River factory were sent East from Summerside yesterday.

The trains East and West of Summerside are now getting back to business and regular traffic has begun. The train leaving Summerside Wednesday evening for Tignish reached its destination at an early hour yesterday morning. Returning it arrived in Summerside about noon and at two fifteen left for the East.

The marriage took place on the 12th inst at the home of Wm Essery, Hanover Street, Summerside, of Miss Carry W. Dammarell, daughter of Robt Dammarell, Freetown, and Edmund Burns of the same place. The Rev Mr Gough, Kensington, was the officiating clergyman. Mr and Mrs Burns left by the afternoon train yesterday for a trip to the Eastern part of the Province.

The death took place at an early hour yesterday morning of Archibald Ramsay, Beach Point, Hamilton, Lot 18. Mr Ramsay was one of the oldest and most respected inhabitants of that section of the Province. He was born 84 years ago on the same farm on which he died. He was a son of the late Hon Donald Ramsay, and leaves two sons, Thomas at home and Norman McL, who lives on the adjoining farm. Mr Ramsay had been in failing health for the past few years, but was able to be around till about 10 days ago, when he took ill and gradually grew worse until the end came.

A special feature of the evening's entertainment was a pantomime "The Sweet Bye and Bye" which greatly impressed the spectators. Much credit is due the two energetic young teachers, Misses George McCarthy and Lucy Gallant for the excellent manner in which the pupils were trained in their different parts.
