WORD FROM THE FIRING LINE

The following letter has been received by Mrs. Henry Lane, Mount Mellick, from Pte. W. C. Glydon, son of Mr. Frank Glydon, Margate, Dear Mrs. Lane.—

Just a few lines to thank you for your kindness in sending socks and cake to me, an entire stranger. There is not much doing around here, and we are out of the line at present, so have a chance to write; but there is not much to write about that we can mention. We have a splendid mail service under the circumstances, we get letters even in the front line with in a few yards of our friends' "enemy," but the papers and parcels are held at battalion base till we get back to reserve or rest.

One of our greatest benefits is the Y. M. C. A., the staff of which is made up of soldiers unfit for further service. At all rest camps they have concerts and lectures in the evenings; also cinema theatres, so we are assured of a pleasant evening in the rest districts. They also have coffee huts along the lines of communication, where we can get a drink of coffee, and after being in the front line in bad weather on the way out a drink of coffee goes good. I have seen a whole platoon fall out at the stall for a few minutes for a rest, and incidentally, coffee, in fact coming out of the line we have never marched past one.

We are in a beautiful part of the country, and it is surprising how the

Well, I guess I will have to close to catch the mail.

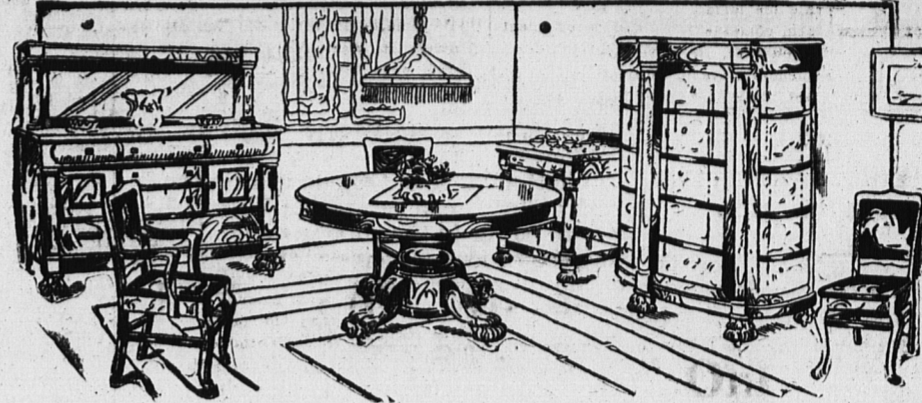

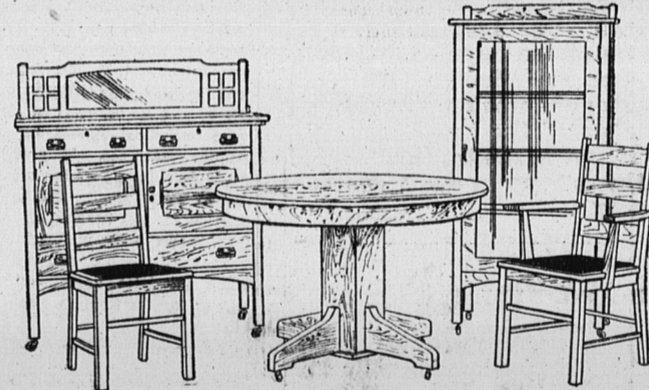

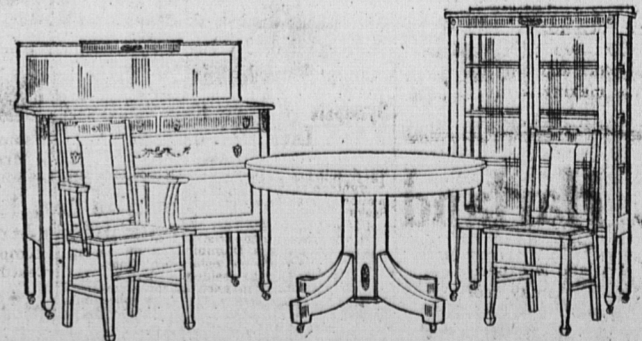
