MIXED MARRIAGES IN NOVA SCOTIA

The Presbytery Appeals Against Archbishop's Pronouncement--Ask Governor's decision Appellants Disclaim Desire to kindle Sectarian Feeling

HALIFAX, N. S., March 27.—The Presbytery of Halifax has appealed to the Lieut.-Governor against the recent pronouncement of Archbishop McCarthy, with reference to mixed marriages, in which it was declared that such marriages not celebrated by a Catholic priest shall be null and void, according to the decree of the Council of Trent.

"The Presbytery in its appeal to the Lieut.-Governor says: 'This Council of Trent assembled in various years of the sixteenth century; its decrees were formed and issued in Catholic countries, and were regarded as having the force of law where Catholicism held supreme authority. That was nearly 350 years ago. To-day it is otherwise with us; this is not a Catholic country, and yet this ancient law is now promulgated to decide what marriages are, or are not, null and void.'

"We, therefore, feel constrained to call upon Your Honor to proclaim authoritatively what law rules in this province regarding marriages, that emanating from Trent or that issued by your honor and your government. We make this appeal from no desire to kindle sectarian feeling but for the sake of social peace, so that no soul of man or woman may be in bondage through doubt of the validity of their marriage. We have not the least desire to embarrass His Grace or his clergy or weaken the discipline of the Catholic church exercised within its proper sphere, nor are we anxious to promote these mixed marriages between Catholics and Protestants, which are charged with frequently bringing about domestic embroilments, still less are we eager to compete as rivals with the priests for the privilege of uniting in marriage their parishioners, but we most earnestly desire to have

it authoritatively and publicly proclaimed by your Government through out of the length and breadth of Nova Scotia that whatever an and woman are married by persons whom you sanction and under the warrant signed by Your Honor, shall be regarded as properly married, no matter what may be the complexion of their religion, and not withstanding all pronouncements to the contrary."

KAISER REJECTS U. S. AMBASSADOR

German Monarch Declined to Receive Dr. Hill as American Minister

WASHINGTON, March 27.—The German Government has declined to receive Dr. David Jayne Hill in the capacity of United States Ambassador or to succeed Charlemagne Tower whose resignation has been accepted to take effect upon the qualification of his successor. Dr. Hill is at present U. S. minister to the Hague and was formerly first assistant secretary of state under the administration of Secretary Hay. The objection to Dr. Hill is purely personal to Emperor William. The Emperor's objection is connected with the visit to America several years ago by his brother, Prince Henry, the ranking admiral of the German navy. Dr. Hill at that time was first assistant Secretary of State and necessarily was brought into official contact with the distinguished foreigners. Just what he did or did not do to give offence is not known here.

HARD TIMES IN LONDON

Brokers Are One of Hardest Hit Classes Just Now

LONDON, March 27.—Doleful tales of hard times are being told in London just now, and while they are palpable exaggerations in some respects, there is no gainsaying the fact that in respect to one set of London's business men they are fairly truthful. There is no doubt that the stock exchange is suffering grievously from the stagnation prevalent for some time past.

It has been stated that as many as 500 members of the stock exchange will not renew their subscriptions. Whether this statement be true or not cannot be verified before the end of March. The deplorable shrinkage in business, however, is shown by the cutting down of office staff. Nearly 100 clerks employed in the "house" have been withdrawn. There are some 5,300 members of the stock exchange at present, and at least a dozen dealers where there is not enough business for one. A member of the stock exchange said today that many of his fellow members had barely enough money in their pockets to pay their train fares.

This dearth of spending money is the basis of many tales of woe in the west end. The times are almost as bad, according to one authority, as just after the Boer War.

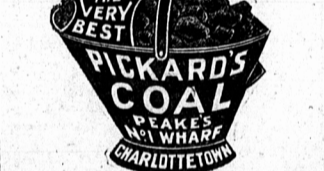
