

# NOTICE TO MOTOR TRUCK OWNERS

The Public Vehicle Act provides that no person shall carry passengers for hire in a motor vehicle unless he holds a franchise to do so unless (1) he is using a vehicle employed solely in taking workmen to and from work over a highway on which no certificate of registration is provided at reasonable times by a franchise holder over such highway, or (2) he is using a vehicle employed on charter to carry passengers on a picnic, outing or similar gathering or to church services over a highway on which no adequate transportation is provided at reasonable times by a franchise holder over such highway.

Instructions have been issued to the R. C. M. P. to prosecute offenders against this Act.

## Winnipeg Grain

WINNIPEG, Sept. 24—(CP)—Trade in barley was a strong feature today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange as heavy demand appeared. Barley prices closed 1-7-8 to 1-3-8 cents higher. Oats, less actively traded, showed modest gains, closing 3-4 to 1-8 cent higher on shipper and American house demand.

Offerings were moderate in barley, but more liberal in oats. Shippers, eastern interests, locals and other houses were on the buying side in barley.

Hedging sales contracted in rye futures trade and prices took on a good tone on demand from commission houses and American interests. At the close, prices were 2 1-2 to 2 1-8 cents higher.

Trade was dull in flax, with prices closing 1-2 cent lower to 1-2 cent higher. Crushers were fair buyers.

No export of Canadian wheat was reported, but 150,000 bushels of Canadian oats was sold overnight to a European country, possibly Belgium.

## Bequests to Mt. A. An J Kentville Hospital

(By The Canadian Press) KENTVILLE, N. S., Sept. 23—Mount Allison University at Sackville, N.B., and Blanchard-Praser Memorial Hospital here have each been bequeathed in trust an estimated \$25,000 by the will probated here today of Mrs. Elizabeth Borden Hewitt. Mrs. Hewitt died at her home in nearby Canning May 12.

Mrs. Hewitt was the daughter of the late Sir Frederick and Lady Borden. Sir Frederick served as Federal Minister of Militia and Defence from 1896 to 1911 in the Laurier Government.

The bequests will eventually amount to \$50,000 each. This represents one third of Mrs. Hewitt's estate, appraised at \$165,000.

One third of the estate is left in trust to Mrs. Hewitt's mother, retaining her lifetime. It will later revert to the Mount Allison and Kentville hospital trust funds. The remaining one third goes to members of the family.

The payments to Mount Allison will be a memorial to Mrs. Hewitt's brother, Harold Lathrop Borden, killed in the Boer War, and to her sister, Maude Borden Macdonald, who died with her husband in the torpedoing of the Lady Hawkins in 1942. The bequest will be used as a scholarship to be known as the Harold Borden-Maude Macdonald Scholarship.
