MR. ASTOR TO ADD TO ESTATE

25 Story Home For the Call.

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., April 7 (Special)—In San Francisco's finest and tallest office building, rising twenty-five stories, at Fourth and Market streets, the busiest corner in the city and in the West, the Call will make its new home.

John D. Sprackles has purchased the property and will erect thereon a steel and reinforced concrete office building in which the new Call will have its home, the structure to be known as the Call Building. It will be the tallest building in San Francisco and the quarters which the Call will occupy will constitute one of the finest newspaper plants in the world. The building will cost \$1,500,000.

The corner of Fourth and Market streets, according to traffic experts, now is, after the corner at Forty-second street, and Broadway, New York and State and Madison streets, Chicago, the busiest intersection in the United States.

FOUGHEE SPRING, N. Y., Vincent Astor is preparing to add many acres throughout the county to his estate at Ferncliff, which he is turning into an experimental farm. At Unaloville Mr. Astor has obtained an option on about 700 acres of land. The farm of Charles Vose, of 120 acres, worth \$3,000; the farm of John U. Able, 325 acres, worth \$8,000, and Vincent Williams' farm, 260 acres, worth \$5,500, are considered by Mr. Astor and he has proceeded an option upon them, according to reports.

Vincent Astor asked Governor Sulzer's advice about buying more land. It is said that the Governor answered, "By all means invest your money in land. It is the safest investment from every point of view. And further your ideas for experimenting upon your farms in Dutchess county."

FRIEDMANN PATIENT SUFFERS A RELAPSE

MONTREAL, April 3.—After being happy for about two weeks, and believing herself to be cured of tuberculosis, as a result of an injection of serum by Dr. Friedmann, the German scientist, Miss Marie Dubois, of La-guachetiere street east, is again confined to bed, unable to walk a step, as was the case before Dr. Friedmann's visit.

Miss Dubois suffers from tuberculosis of the glands and of the joints and had been in bed for four months previous to Dr. Friedmann's visit, March 11th. Her case had been considered almost hopeless by medical authorities in the city, and she was chosen as one of the patients to be treated at the Royal Edward Institute. The young lady was given two injections, and sent to her home. For three days she suffered considerably, perspiring much, and then, on the fourth morning, she was able to get out of bed and walk about. Her glands showed signs of improvement as well.

Her one hope is that she may be treated again and cured once more, the second cure to be permanent, however.

Of the other patients treated by Dr. Friedmann in Montreal, more encouraging reports are heard. Mr. John McCabby and the twelve-year-old boy, Maurice Allard, at the Hotel Dieu were reported to be showing signs of improvement, but there has been nothing of a jump in the change in their condition, as was the case with Miss Dubois.

Dr. Harding, of the Royal Edward Institute, who is looking after the majority of the patients treated by Dr. Friedmann, has nothing to say as yet as to their condition, nor is anything definite given out as regards the patients of the Bruchsal Institute.

Nothing is known as to when Dr. Friedmann, or one of his assistants will arrive in Montreal, as was promised; or when a supply of the serum for further experiment will be sent.

YOUNG EDISON IN BOMB MISHAP

NEW YORK, April 3.—Theodore Edison, the fourteen year old son of Thomas A. Edison and an earnest rival, had an experience in West Orange, N. J., that recalled today to his amused father a similar mishap to himself fifty-years ago.

Theodore was experimenting to invent a floating bomb. There was an explosion and a doctor is still picking pieces of glass out of Theodore's anatomy. His father's similar experience was in a laboratory he had fitted out in a baggage car when he was a train newsboy. The railway could not view with complacency the burning of a baggage car every time the boy hit upon a new idea, so he had to remove his outfit.

KIN OF RENOWNED EXPLORER FIRED

Senhortia da Gama Acquitted of Conspiracy in Lisbon.

LISBON, April 7 (Special)—Senhortia Constancia Tallos da Gama, a descendant of Vasco da Gama, the celebrated Portuguese explorer, who discovered the passage to India around the Cape of Good Hope, was acquitted by a court martial before which she had been tried on an accusation of conspiring against the Portuguese republic.

The case has excited intense interest throughout Portugal on account of the ancestry of the accused woman, her wealth and youth and her devotion in relieving the sufferings of royalists prisoners incarcerated since the revolution.

Another woman and a priest who were tried at the same time fellow conspirators were found guilty by the military court.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years, or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$20 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the home stead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry including the time required to erect homestead patent and cultivate fifty acres extra. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain pre-emption may enter a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$20 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.00.
