HOCKEY.

Two fast, clean games of hockey were played at Montague Wednesday night between the Y. M. C. A. team Charlottetown and the Montague Imperials and the Charlottetown West Kent School team and the Montague high school team.

The special train from Charlottetown carrying the two teams and their supporters arrived in Montague at 8 o'clock. The first match began at nine o'clock between the two senior teams.

The ice was excellent and there was a fair attendance. It was nothing but hockey all the time and fast hockey. In the first five minutes Montague scored two goals and in four minutes more Charlottetown scored their first goal and in ten minutes more Montague scored their third and the score stood at half time 3-1 in favor of Montague.

In the second half after six minutes fast play the visiting team scored their second goal. Five minutes more and they made another. The count now stood 3-3. The play became even faster and more interesting than ever.

The Montague boys made another rally and in four minutes made another goal, which stood this way till within half a minute of time when the Charlottetown boys made their last and fourth goal. The count now stood 4-4. No penalties were imposed on either parties which is a rare thing in hockey.

The Montague team will have to go to Charlottetown for a return match and the most points in the two games will prove the winners. The second game between the two school teams was sharp, interesting and fast and the visiting team had more than they could handle.

At half time the score was 5-0 for Montague. Second half Montague team scored four more and the Charlottetown boys got two goals. The game ended 9-2 for Montague and no penalties imposed for scrapping over the rubber.
