**EGG LAYING CONTEST**

Production in the Charlottetown Egg Laying Contest has gradually dropped down as follows: For the week ended Sept. 18, the production was 546 eggs, for the week ended Sept. 25, 461, for the week ending October 2, 354, for the week ending October 9, 346, and for the week ending October 16, Pendleton Bros. Barred Rocks are 278 eggs. On September 18, and 5th, with 1459 eggs; Mr. Everett Pendleton Bros. pen had led the contest, with Mrs. F. W. Wolley's pen Laren, Mr. J. B. Millman and Mr. H. L. Machon following quite closely. For the first two weeks of October, Mr. Millman's pen of Barred Rocks led by a narrow margin; and during the past week Mrs. R. G. McLaren's pen tied with Mrs. J. J. McLeod's White Wyandottes for first place with 25 eggs each; Mrs. D. J. Carmichael's pen was 2nd, with 24 eggs, and the Experimental Station's pen of White Leghorns No. 20 tied with 21 eggs each; Mr. H. S. Moase's White Leghorns for 3rd place with 21 eggs each; F. W. Wolley's White Leghorn No. 31 has laid 216 eggs; Mr. Everett Howatt's White Leghorn No. 1 has laid 209 eggs, and the Experimental pen of Barred Rocks was 5th, with 19 Station's White Leghorn No. 191, has laid 200 eggs.
