A Safety Campaign

There were close to 6,000,000 motor vehicle accidents in the United States and Canada last year. Thousands of people were killed; over a million injured. An analysis shows that a high percentage of these accidents was due to faulty driving.

Unsafe cars are responsible for another high percentage of traffic accidents. Faulty brakes, a broken windshield wiper, dangerous tires, and inferior or burned-out headlights increase the chances of an accident and make accidents far more serious than they otherwise would be.

And what are we to remember this time, what is there interesting in the story of the building of the bridge to the Hillsborough River was wide, a bridge was built over it. On the north side of the river was a large square, or plaza, and as the water rose quite high, it ceased a whirlpool. It was a large square cup and saucer standing on the bridge afforded safe protection.

About fifty yards beyond the bridge and standing upon rising ground was an object of great interest to all. A large vat had been built for the purpose of rendering oil from seals, brought in by the Island sealing vessels. Whose venture it was or whether it was successful we do not know but there it stood for many years in appearance the vat reminding us of a large square cup and saucer standing fully twenty feet high and about a foot from the ground.

Ships with immigrants came to this port every two or three years in the 1840's. The "Hillsborough" of St. John, N.B., brought a large number of passengers at different times. In 1841, she arrived with a cargo of seal-bags, with six hundred and thirty passengers on board; twenty-six died before they came to this port, and within a few days.

Of course the arrival of this ship caused great consternation to the people of Charlottetown. What was to be done with the ill and dying immigrants so unexpectedly thrown upon the shore? Where Do We Go From Here?

The adjournment indefinitely of the Dominion-Provincial Conference is a sad blow to this Province, to the Maritime Provinces in general, and to the Prairie Provinces as well. Whether chief responsibility for the failure to come to terms lies with the Central Provinces, as Premier Jones alleges, or with the Dominion Government in its refusal to consider further proposals, as Premier Drew claims and as others have stated, as a matter of comparatively little importance.

At this rate, and failing settlement of our fiscal needs at Ottawa, it is no wonder that Premier Jones has decided that "economy" will have to be practised.

The Federal Budget is now the all-important event anxiously awaited—what will Finance Minister Isley offer in substitution for his financial plan turned down by the Conference?

Premier Jones knows where he can reduce our expenditure by over \$3,000,000 to \$10,000,000 in substitution for the loss of \$5,000,000,000 subsidy to enable us to make ends meet comfortably.
