Control Cutworms Early in Spring

Cutworms are usually active and feeding before most crops are even in the ground. Hence, says Alan G. Duffin, Division of Entomology, Dominion Department of Agriculture, it is important to be prepared for their attacks at the first of the season.
Bran bait has given effective control for many years. It is made up of bran, 29 lb. Paris green, one-half lb. molasses, one quart, and water, about 2 1-2 gallons.
