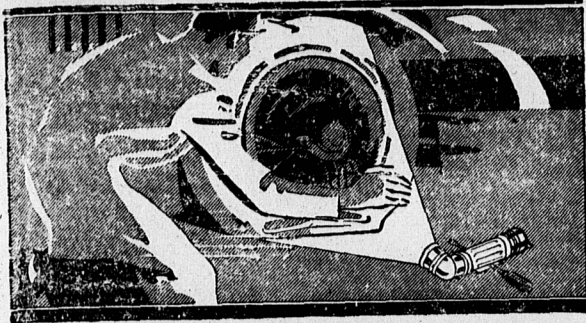

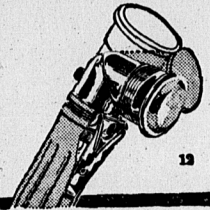

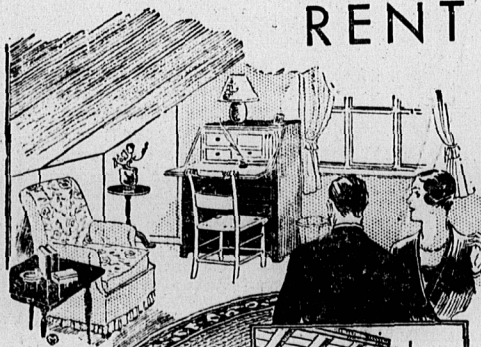

### Discuss Causes Of Disaster

(Canadian Press)  
**LONDON, Oct. 28.**—Causes of the disaster which overtook the British dirigible R-101 resulting in the loss of 48 lives was discussed at the opening of Britain's formal inquiry into the catastrophe today. The first session of the court of inquiry furnished several surprises. One of these came when Sir William Jowitt revealed that a cable controlling an elevator in the air ship had been found broken in the wreckage. Another was his disclosure that experimental oil engines in the ship weighed eight tons more than originally planned, 17 tons as against 9. Sir William also said a possible cause of the tragic end of the world's largest flying craft might have been some error in the working of its altimeter. Sir John Simon, presiding at the inquiry, added to Sir William's conjecture the statement that "some influence from the ground to send information might have influenced the fate of the R-101."

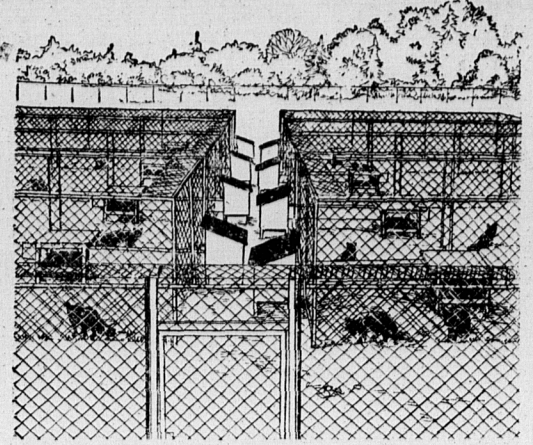
