Text Of Feed Grain Elevator Resolution

Following is the text of the grain elevator resolution, moved by Harold Horitz, Royalty, and seconded by Cecil Ingram, Herbert, which was discussed at Thursday's annual meeting of the P.E.I. Federation of Agriculture and held over for consideration by the Association directors.

"Whereas, because of favourable climatic and atmospheric conditions, aided by an ample supply of pure drinking water, strong sunlight, heavy morning dews, and frequent rains in average years during the summer growing season, animal life of all kinds thrives in Prince Edward Island and is free from many diseases common to other countries and districts; and

"Whereas, because of the above favourable living conditions, the farmers of P.E.I. are enabled to specialize in all the branches of the dairy industry, including milk, butter, cheese, etc., in the breeding and fattening of hogs for the production of grade 'A' Wiltshire sides, in the raising of high grade breeding cattle, for export abroad, and in the breeding of poultry, including geese and turkeys, from all of which large quantities of eggs and dressed fow are obtained; and

"Whereas, in proportion as the population on the Island of the different animals and birds increases, so there will be required larger quantities of grain for feeding purposes; and

"Whereas, in the Province of Prince Edward Island, because of the limited acreage, feed grains cannot be raised to the same advantage either in quality or quantity, as in the Prairie Provinces, where by mass producing methods and with a colder winter and drier summer climate they are able to produce larger quantities of drier harder grain at a lower cost; and

"Whereas, up to the present time all the Prairie grains have been transported to Prince Edward Island by rail rather than by boat; and

"Whereas, because the boats have been available owing to their being otherwise employed, all Western grain has been transported to Eastern Canada by rail. The freight charge for same as determined by the Transport Commission is 42 cents per 100 lbs. the equivalent on the average weights of the different grains of 21 cents per bushel, as against a pre-war ship rate of 18 cents per bushel; and

"Whereas, because of the high rail freight charged on the Western grain shipped to Eastern Canada, farmers and others and because an accumulation of grain in the West called for the creation of a demand for same in Eastern Canada, Parliament passed an Act, known as the 'Freight Assistance Act', under which an allowance is made to all importers in Eastern Canada of Western grain of 39 1/2 cents
