C. P. R. EARNINGS MONTREAL, Sept. 25.—(CP)—Increase of \$1,450,000 was reported today by Canadian Pacific Railway in trading earnings of \$4,569,000 for the week ended Sept. 21, compared with \$3,365,000 for the corresponding period a year ago.

(By Frederick Gardner Associated Press Financial Writer.) NEW YORK, Sept. 25.—(AP)—Traders tread cautiously in the stock market today and the result was a highly mixed performance. A feeble attempt to rally put leaders up fractions to around a point after a quiet opening but profit taking intervened and reluctance to hold positions overnight cut or erased gains near the close. The pace was never fast and traders totalled 1,225,610 shares compared with 1,660,590 on Friday. The Associated Press average of 60 representative stocks was unchanged at 52.8.

Interest in the Canadian section centered on Lake Shore which picked up 1 3/4 points to 27. Other activity was slight. Dome, Walkers, Imperial Oil and Imperial Tobacco made fractional advances while International Nickel, McIntyre and Marconi eased. United States Steel and Bethlehem dipped in the final half hour for small fractional losses. Y-units-town just kept its head above water. General Motors was unchanged and Chrysler up a shade.

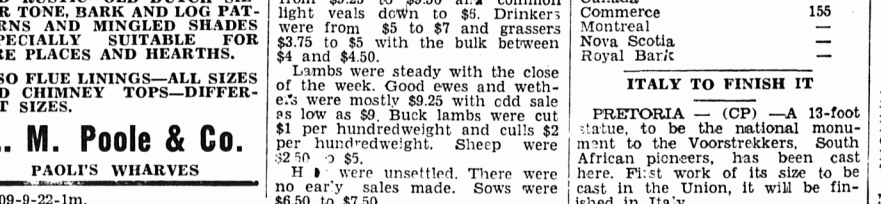

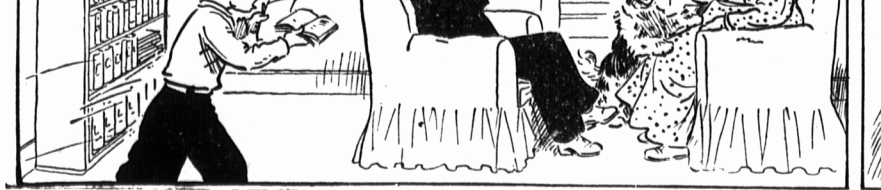

TORONTO, Sept. 25.—(CP)—The Toronto stock market put its best foot forward in the final hour today and prices were firming on good volume at the close. Western oils featured the list, trading in quantity and advancing 1.7 in the index while one of the industrials finished .35 up in the index and the mining groups registered practically no net change. Volume was the heaviest since Sept. 15 at 434,000 shares.

Abitibi pfd moved up 2 3/4 for the day to close at 18 3/4. Consolidated Paper closed at 9. 3-8 up. Great Lakes Paper pfd gained 2 1-4 and the Voting Trust added 3-4. The Steel of Canada issues firmed 1-2. Dominion Steel B 7-8. Dominion Bridge 2 and Hamilton Bridge 3-8.

Home Oil closed 13 cents up at 2.90 and Calgary-Edmonton gained 15 cents. Okalta advanced 14 cents, Poothills 20 and Anglo-Canadian 6.
