FUNERAL TO-DAY.—The remains of the late Charles Cairns, who died in Millinocket, Maine, came to Charlottetown by the mail special yesterday, accompanied by his friend, Mr. Buck. The remains were forwarded yesterday afternoon to Emerald Junction, the home of his uncle, Robert Cairns. The funeral takes place this afternoon at two o'clock, interment being in North Tryon cemetery.

GOLDEN WEDDING.—From an Evansville, Wis., paper of recent date, The Guardian clips the following, which will be of interest to the many friends of the parties referred to: Z. C. and Mrs. Moore of this city who celebrated their fiftieth wedding anniversary at the home of their daughter, Mrs. H. A. Blakely, are pioneer residents of Rock County. The groom of fifty years was the son of William Moore of Germany and Phila. Wright of Vermont and was born in Fulton County, N. Y. Feb. 29, 1836. Mrs. Moore who previous to her marriage was Frances Victoria Rodd, the daughter of John Rodd of Prince Edward Island and Caroline Horn of Kent, England, was born Jan. 4th, 1846 at Brackley Point, Prince Edward Island. At the age of eleven she went with her parents to Boston and came overland to Wisconsin, stopping at Jonesville. Mr. Rodd bought a farm and saw mill at West Magnolia. He died three years later and his family lived with his elder brother, where Mrs. Moore's marriage was solemnized. Mr. and Mrs. Moore remained on the farm until March, 1906 when he retired from active business and moved to Evansville. Four of their daughters were present at the golden wedding celebration, two other daughters, one in California and the other in Philadelphia being unable to be present.

Mrs. Moore, above referred to is a sister of Mrs. Walter Mallie, United Road, Mrs. John Mett, North River, and Wm. E. Rodd, North Wiltshire. ASKS FOR GRANTS.—Hon. John Richards, has returned to Charlottetown from a trip to Upper Canada, where he visited Montreal, Ottawa, Toronto and other cities. He was absent from the Island about three weeks. While at Toronto he attended many of the meetings of the Live Stock Associations of which he is a member. These meetings were very largely attended by farmers and live stock men from all over the Dominion and much interest was manifested in the work. Mr. Richards was particularly interested in the meetings of the Clydesdale, Short-horn, and Aberdeen Angus Breeders' Associations, of which he is President for the Island. He was the only representative from this province present. He was successful in securing a grant of \$150 from the Clydesdale Association, to be offered in prize money for pure-bred Clydesdales at the provincial exhibition. He also endeavored to secure a grant from the Shorthorn Association for a similar purpose, but as the membership on the Island is so small, it was difficult to get the consent of the Association for the appropriation, but it is to be hoped as the membership increases here, that a substantial grant will be obtained. Mr. Richards was re-elected to the same office which he has held in the above Associations for some years. While away, he purchased a number of pure-bred animals which will arrive on the Island in the early part of April or soon after navigation opens.
