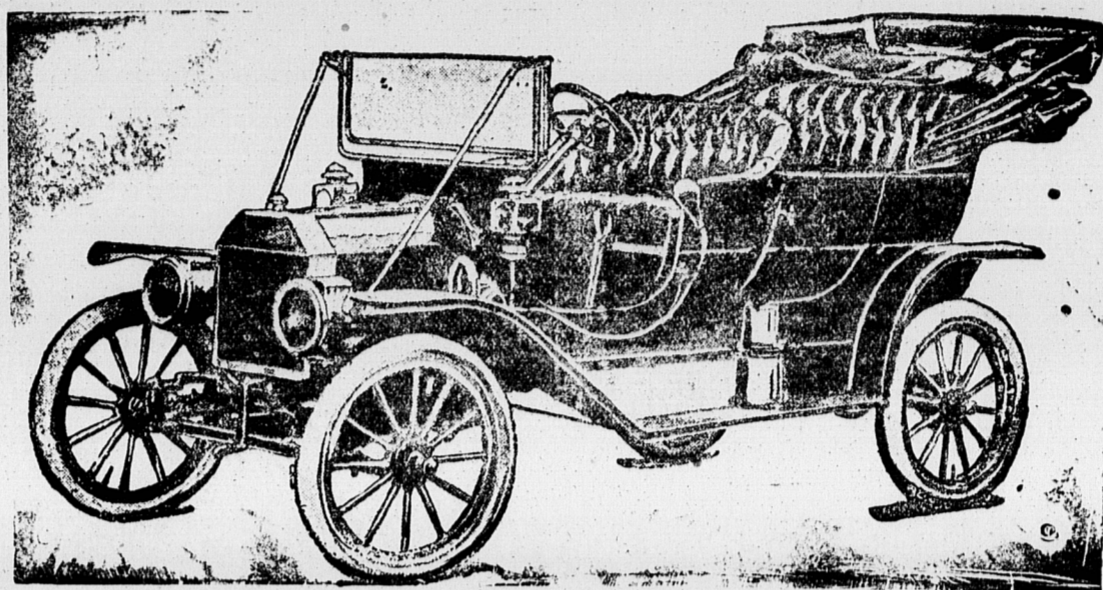
Why and Wherefore

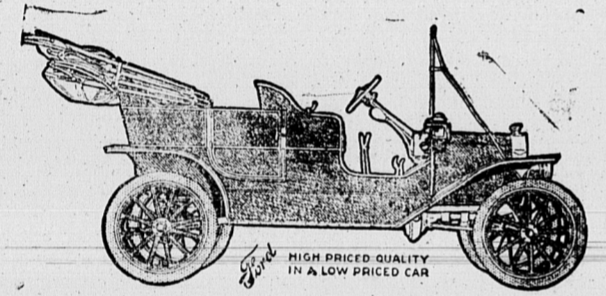

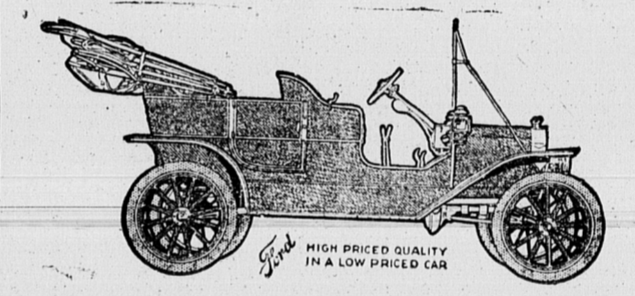

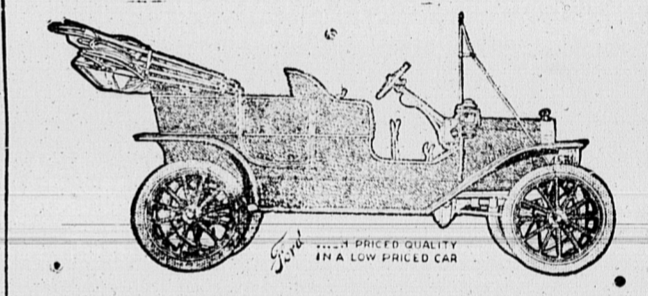

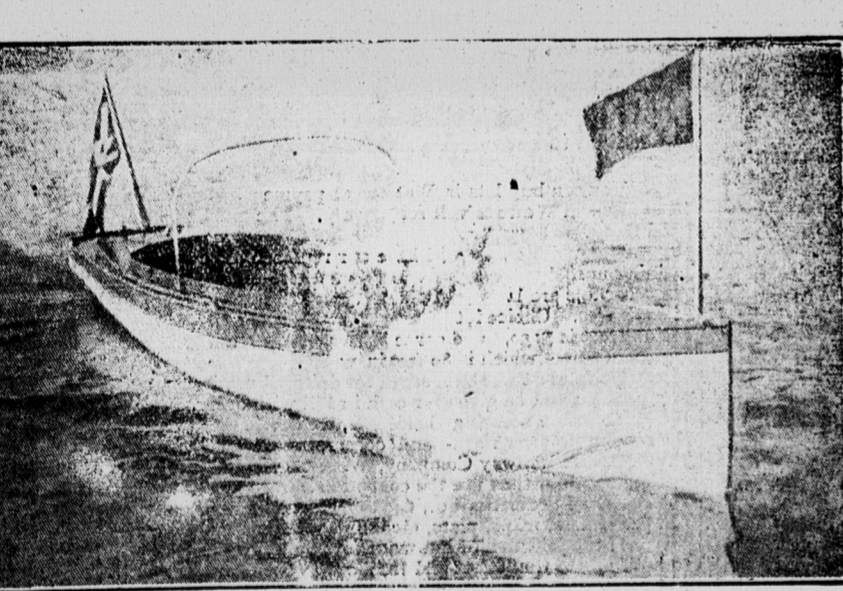

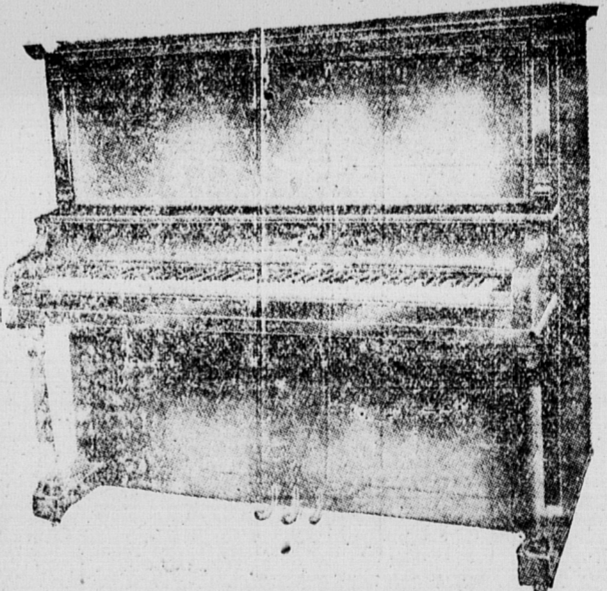
