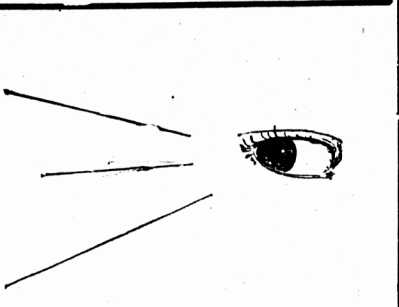

Twenty-Eight Royal Guests In Britain For Royal Wedding

Twenty-eight members of foreign Royal Houses are coming to Britain to be present at the wedding of Princess Elizabeth. These guests, among whom are four Kings and six Queens, are all personal friends or relatives of the Princess or Lieutenant Mountbatten. They are attending the marriage at the invitation of the King and Queen. The Royal Family will be seated within the sanctuary rails as at previous Royal Marriages which for so many centuries have been solemnized in the Abbey. Other seats will be occupied by visiting Royalities, official representatives of Commonwealth countries and other nations and personal friends of the bride couple.
