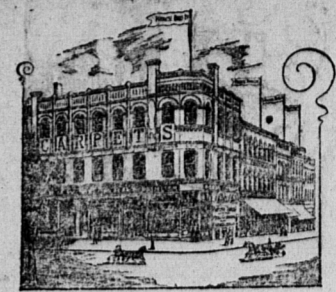

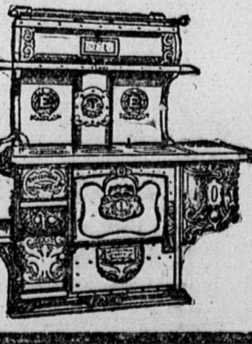

WILLARD BUGLEY'S TERRIBLE DEATH

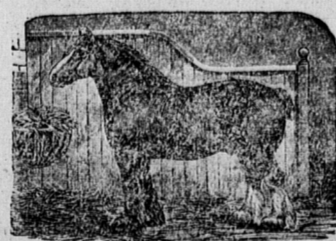
