Contract Bridge

CONSERVATION OF HONORS

It does not always pay to give up a high honor simply because it is "no good anyway," being as it does under an opposing tenace. Observe East's weak defense in today's deal.

South dealer. Both sides vulnerable.

The bidding:
South West North East
1 ♠ Pass 1 ♠ Pass

South's last bid was a gamble inasmuch as he had not received any real support from North in either diamonds or clubs, and since there was not even any assurance that North had the top hearts.

West, trying to protect his potential club tricks, opened the trump suit. The nine was put in from dummy, and East, with disgust written plainly on his face, tossed in the trump king. Declarer won, cashed the ace and king of clubs, and ruffed a club in dummy. East had to sit by impotently and watch the trump five take the trick since he himself was down to the three and deuce of trumps. Declarer returned to his hand with the spade ace, ruffed another club, cashed the top hearts, discarding his spade jack, then ruffed a spade. Now all he had to do was draw trumps and cash the fifth club for the full-filling trick.

East was entirely too pessimistic regarding the power of his trump king. Most certainly he

should not have parted with that card on the first trick. If he had held it, he could have overuffed dummy on the third lead of clubs and returned a trump, thus protecting his partner's club trick, and this would have left the declarer high and dry in his slam contract.
