NEW TYPE RAILWAY CAR DESIGNED AND BUILT IN MARITIMES

The first steam generator car to be built in Canada has just rolled out of the Moncton Shops of the Canadian National Railways. For use in conjunction with the operation of diesel-electric locomotives in passenger service, the new car will heat the trains in winter time. Tests have proved that the unit will operate in train service for a week without refuelling even in below zero temperatures. Designed and built by the C.N.R.'s Atlantic Region engineers and car builder's for use in Prince Edward Island, it will serve as a pattern for others to be constructed for the system.

In the top photograph is shown the exterior of the new steam generator car painted in standard C.N.R. passenger car green with gold lettering. It is 43 feet, seven inches long, nine feet, ten inches wide, and 15 feet high from rails.

The sketch shows the interior layout. One is the oil-fired boiler which has a capacity of 3,000 pounds of steam per hour; two, the two-horsepower diesel motor generating power for fuel ignition, blower fans, controls, lighting, air compressor and battery charging; three, the three-horsepower air compressor having a capacity of 16 cubic feet of free air per minute; four, the two inter-connected 1,100-gallon each water tanks; five, 24-volt batteries—three trays of four cells each; six, the 325-gallon fuel oil tank; seven, the four windows; eight, the four doors and nine, the two lockers.
