SCORES DIE AS COLD WAVE GRIPS U.S.

ACCIDENTS ACCOUNT FOR MANY DEATHS

All States East of Rockies Affected By Cold Wave.

(A. P. By Guardian's Special Wire) CHICAGO, Dec. 26.—The United States counted 108 deaths today in the bitter cold that beset all the states east of the Rockies.

Motor vehicle and other accidents attributed to the weather cost 48 lives, exposure 37 and fires 15. Five persons drowned after carbon monoxide fumes resulted in three deaths.

Temperatures dropped far below zero in the northwest. Zero and near zero cold formed the rule in the tier of Central States. Ditch

Forecasters expected moderation to set in west of the Mississippi River tonight but predicted only continued cold and even colder conditions for virtually all the other states.

Ohio topped the death list with 22 fatalities. Pennsylvania had 17, Michigan 10 and Illinois eight. Five deaths were reported in Ohio, West Virginia and New York three each, Minnesota, Iowa, Michigan, Wisconsin and Pennsylvania, two each, Missouri, New Jersey, Indiana, Tennessee, Montana and North Carolina one each.

Pennsylvania tabulated 13 deaths in accidents, four nine, Michigan seven, Indiana and Kansas five each, Maryland four, West Virginia two, and North Dakota, Illinois and Missouri one each.

Ohio had five deaths due to fire, Vermont and Texas three each, and Iowa, Michigan, Virginia and West Virginia one each.

Four of the drownings occurred

Parliament Likely To Meet January 30

By Guardian's Special Wire) OTTAWA, Dec. 26.—Plans for the first session of the new Parliament are going forward rapidly with the permanent staffs of the various departments working on estimates, reports and legislation, and the Finance Department busy with the budget. The opening date is expected to be Jan. 30.

Continuing in the session of Laurier House, where he spent the Christmas holiday with only a slight pause in his work, Prime Minister Mackenzie King did not come to his office today and no cabinet sessions were in sight. The Prime Minister was spending this week at home in an attempt to catch up with his heavy correspondence, and to work undisturbed on his legislative policies.

Concern Felt In Far East Tension Chinese Troops Dispatched To Curb Student Demonstration In Shanghai.

(By Morris J. Harris Associated Press Foreign Staff) SHANGHAI, Dec. 27.—(Friday)—(A. P.)—Chinese troops went into action today to block an anti-Japanese student demonstration as worried officials of the Chinese Republic sought to check a growing Sino-Japanese tension.

An armored train bearing 500 soldiers was dispatched to prevent students from reaching the capital. Serious effects resulting from the assassination Christmas Day of Tang Yu-Jen, pro-Japanese Vice Minister of Chinese railways, were predicted by Maj. Gen. Rensuke Isogai, military attache here of the Japanese Embassy.

He said the slaying was a result of Sino efforts to "normalize" relations between China and Japan.

Because of the growing tension, government officials redoubled their efforts to suppress peacefully student demonstrations. An emissary was sent to urge the Shanghai students to abandon their attempt to reach Nanking and instead to take up their grievances through an authorized delegation.

Plans for a huge demonstration by Nanking students were nipped when the government issued a proclamation forbidding public gatherings or parades there.

Japanese military sources said the assassination of Tang "throws a dark shadow over the future of Sino-Japanese relations."

Martial law, ordered after the slaying, remained in force in Shanghai and in Nanking. Military regulations were laid down at Hankow, where demonstrations against the North China autonomy movement have been serious.

French police insisted that the Tang assassination, which took place in the French concessions, was a political one. A spokesman of the Japanese Embassy said it was "glaring evidence of anti-Japanese sentiment, leaving no doubt of the trend of Chinese thought toward Japan."

He pointed to the recent attempt to assassinate Wang Ching-wei, who resigned shortly afterward as Premier. This shooting took place at Nanking.

(C. P. By Guardian's Special Wire) OTTAWA, Dec. 26.—Lawyers will predominate in the House of Commons when Canada's 18th Parliament opens early in 1936. In a Commons where a greater variety of vocations will be represented than the House has seen since Confederation, the legal fraternity will hold a total of 74 of the 245 seats.

Capturing 41 constituencies in the October general elections, farmers will occupy second place in numerical strength. Merchants will be third with 20 seats, and medical doctors in fourth place with 14.

The teaching profession will be represented by nine, manufacturers five and clergymen three. Of those who gave their vocations as gentlemen in their nomination papers, nine won the right to sit.

Occupations of the legislators vary all the way from a chef to a lady. The self-described lone ordinary expert is J. C. Landeryou, Social Credit member-elect for Calgary East. Miss Agnes Macphail, successful as a UFO-Labour candidate in Grey-Bruce, filled in the occupational space as a "lady."

Mrs. George Black, wife of the former speaker, elected in the Yukon as an Independent Conservative, gave her post as "married woman."
