**STOCK QUOTATIONS**

**Stock Markets At A Glance**

**TORONTO, May 28 - (CP) -** The Toronto Stock Market divided about equally on gains and losses in today's trading. Gains were up and the Base Metals and Western Oils took small losses.

**MONTREAL, May 28 - (CP) -** Industrials in fairly brisk trading, moved up to new seasonal highs on the indices today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market. In the other pivotal groups utilities were higher and papers, golds and banks down in the averages. Junior mines also were lower. Individual fluctuations for the most part were small. The market was the broadest in five years.

**CHICAGO, May 28 - (CP) -** All deliveries of wheat, eye and corn soared to new seasonal highs today, meeting little profit cashing resistance until the final hour when offerings came out in volume. Stop-loss orders were uncovered in all markets before the advance was checked.

**NEW YORK, May 28 - (AP) -** Urgent investment demand today lifted the Stock Market to a new 8-year peak.

Dealings were relatively fast at intervals after the start, transfers of 1,570,000 shares compared with 1,300,000 Friday and were the largest since May 8. Pivotal industrials led the push but individual rallies exhibited strength. Top advances running to 2 or more points were trimmed in most cases at the close. The Associated Press 60-stock average was up 7 of a point at 66.6, widest since April 16. It was a new high since Aug. 25, 1937. Industrial, rail and utility composites also registered best levels in eight years.
