The hauling of firewood, lumber, etc., is now being energetically pursued by the farmers here.

In many localities besides keeping the road through the district open, they are obliged to break and keep open "cross roads" on which for long distances nobody resides. This makes a rather busy time after each snow storm, and often prolonged delay in getting these extra roads cleared in time to suit an exacting public.

Mr. McEwen is eminently qualified for such work, and we believe this is the first of our local Governments to conceive such an idea, the results of which will be keenly noted.

### EGG LAYING CONTEST.

Notes on the P. E. Island Egg Laying Contest for the Ninth Week ending Jan. 2, 1926.

Rather adverse weather conditions prevailed during the week and the total production was only 522 eggs.

The Experimental station, White Leghorns pen No. 1, lead for the week with 32.1 points. Mr. Talmage Foster's Barred Rocks were second with 31.4 points, Everett Howatt's White Leghorns were third with 30.1 points; and Mrs. F. McIntyre's White Leghorns were fourth with 30 points.

Mr. Talmage Foster's Barred Rocks lead the contest to date with a total of 237.9 points. Everett Howatt's pen of White Leghorns are second with 185.5 points. The Experimental Station, White Leghorns pen No. 1, are third, and their White Leghorns pen No. 4 are fourth with 182.3 and 170.3 points respectively. Mr. Charles McKenna's Barred Rocks are fifth with 163.7 points to date.

The total number of eggs laid to date is 2386 or 22.9 per cent of a possible.  
The total points awarded to date is 2249.4.  
Thirteen eggs were disallowed during the week as being under weight.
