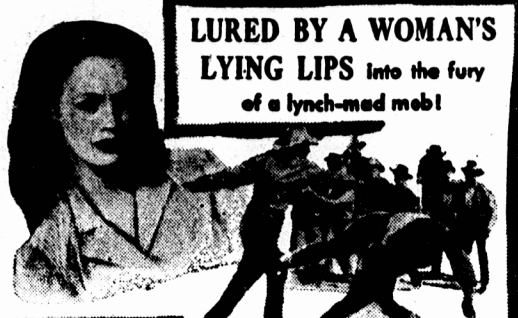

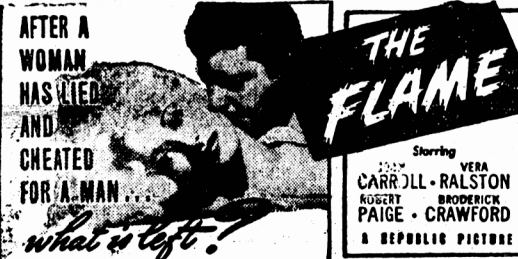

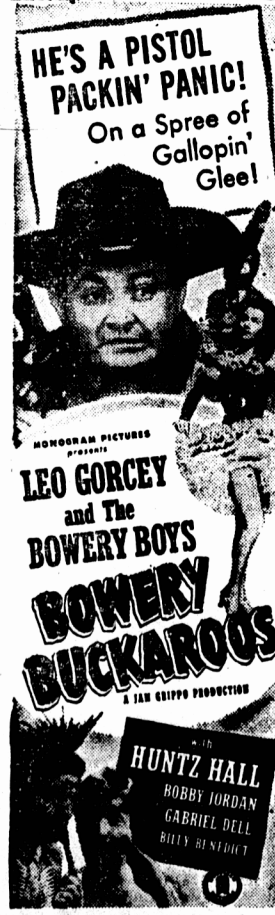

Wartime Treatment For Cripples To Aid Housewives

Blakeslee (Associated Press Science Editor) CLEVELAND, Jan. 8 (AP) — There are 5,000,000 crippled and disabled United States housewives, Dr. Howard Rusk of New York told the American Medical Association today, who can be helped by the same "miracle treatments" given crippled war veterans.

He told of plans to extend this form of treatment, which he called the third phase of medicine, to the women in their homes. And he said there are 23,000,000 Americans disabled or crippled who also can benefit from this new medical concept.

Veterans who before the last war would have remained hopeless cripples for life are returning to work due to studies which find out what motions or strains their muscles will stand, and then training this partial physique.

WELLINGTON, N.Z., Jan. 7 (CP) — Winner of the Victoria Cross for outstanding gallantry in the Western Desert during the Second World War, Keith Elliot of Wellington has been ordained as a clergyman of the Church of England.
