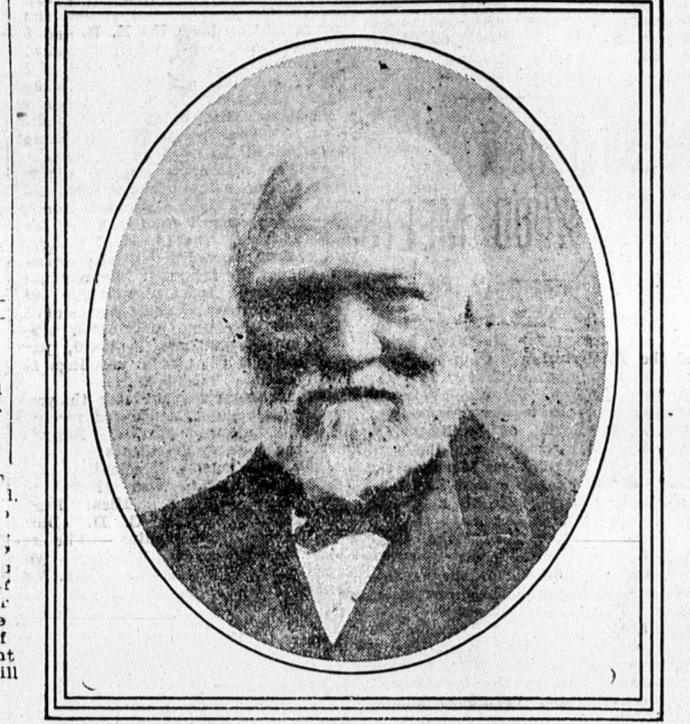

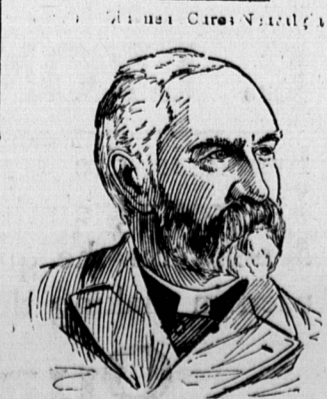

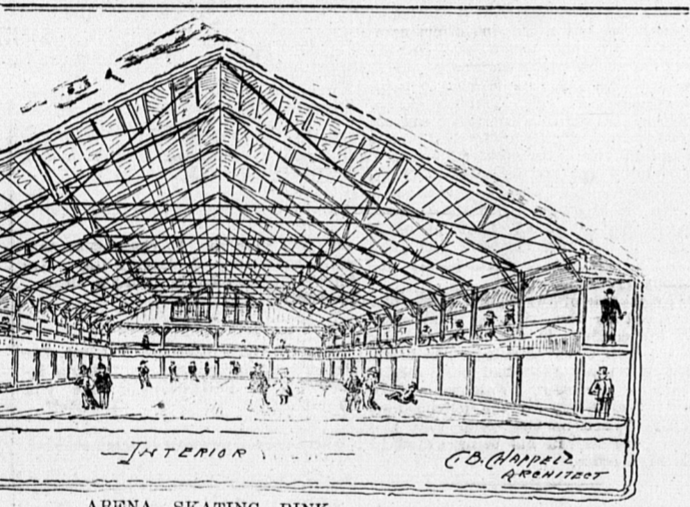
ARENA SKATING RINK. In which healthful Exercise can be obtained next winter.



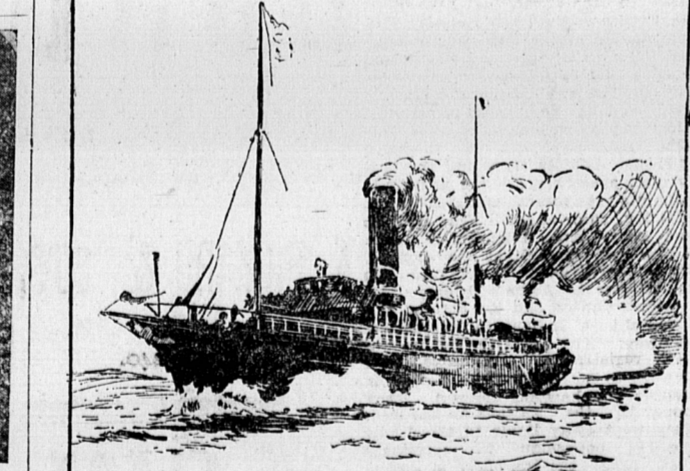

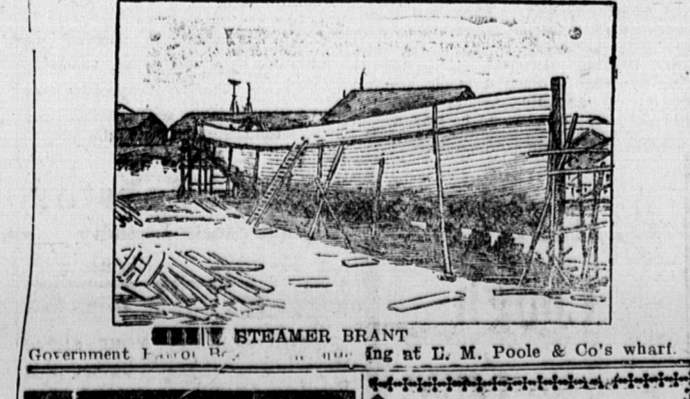
