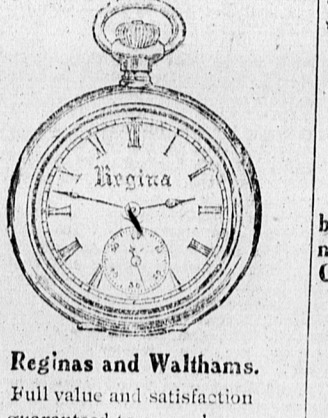

## AN APPRECIATION OF REV. MR FULLERTON

Fullerton appears in a recent issue of the "Presbyterian" published in Toronto:—"Some men make much stir in the public eye, and have very small resources to back them.
