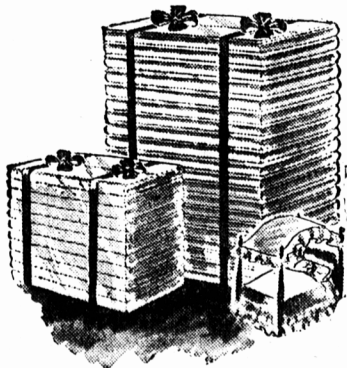
FIRE STILL BURNING
