Cash, became the party slogan. And the Schemers, grown bolder and wanting more money to spend, in bold effrontery dared to tell the people that they would build hundreds of miles of these roads at an outlay of from one to two thousand dollars a mile without adding to the province debt or costing the taxpayers a single cent! And some very silly persons were foolish and stupid enough to believe them—more's the pity.

People are now waking up to see the latest craze in its true light. Notably the farmers on both sides of the national border line are beginning to count the cost. They are not so prosperous as they were and are thinking of hard work and economy as still of some consequence. Farm Stock and Home, a leading agricultural journal of Minnesota, rises to say "Taxation is now out of all proportion to the earnings of at least ninety per cent of the people of this state and is far out of proportion to the incomes of one hundred per cent of the farmers. This being so, the sensible course is to cut expenditure to the bone. States have no more right to purchase improvements beyond their means than individuals have to purchase extravagantly." This was written in protest against a proposed road-building loan.

The Farmers' Sun of Toronto endorses this protest and takes note of Premier Durney's recent declaration before the Good Roads Association that "the time has come for a curtailment of road expenditure." The Farmers' Sun adds: "We can and must slow up on the ambitious programme on which we embarked three years ago." The Moncton Times, Conservative, points out the dangers of growing provincial debt and taxation and referring to the work on improved highways adds that "the money has been largely wasted and the back country roads have been neglected." These are the same complaints that have been made here but which have fallen upon heedless ears. On with the dance; borrow and spend; let the future take care of itself! And what will the end be?

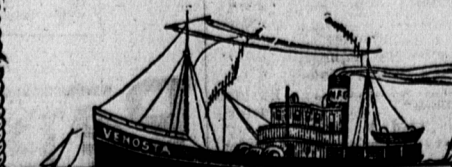


### Haddock a la Lobster

Add several tablespoons of vinegar and set until haddock absorbs pimento coloring. Arrange on lettuce leaves and serve with salted dressing. (Mrs. H. A. Dickson, Dartmouth.)
