New Air Flight Is Inaugurated

HALIFAX, April 1—The inaugural flight in the new trans-Canada Air Lines service which provides another link between Canada and the United States, took off this (Tuesday) morning from Halifax for Boston with passengers, air mail and express. Included among the passengers, was A. M. Mackay, president of the Halifax Board of Trade and representing the Mayor of Halifax. Others were Lieut. Shirley Beck of the Canadian Naval Nursing Service, Mr. and Mrs. W.A. Fisher, Rev. J.D. Keane

of Boston, Captain Dowling, Mrs. H. Mosher, D. Pedersen for New York; and B. White for Bermuda via New York.

Air mail included a consignment of first class covers from all over Canada and with the air express was a package of illustrated literature descriptive of the province of Nova Scotia, consigned by the Hon. Harold Connolly, Minister of Industry and publicity in the Nova Scotia Government to the Boston Tourist Agency.

N. B. Gov't Moves To Operate Mines

FREDERICTON, April 1—(CP)—An act to empower the Crown to take possession and operate temporarily (the coal) mines in the Minto-Chipman area was introduced in the New Brunswick Legislature today. The bill was given first and second reading and it was indicated that third reading would be given before adjournment today.

Premier J.B. McNair introduced the bill and said it was presented because "all avenues of an agreement with striking miners in the area have failed."
