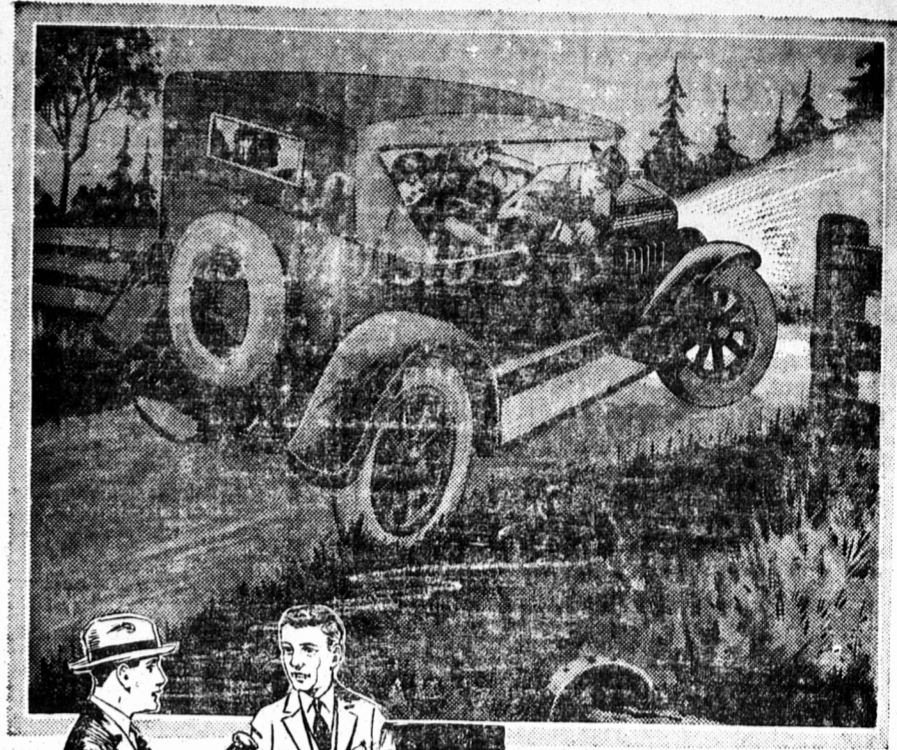

Mrs Victor Leonard and family and her sister, Miss Ida McDonald, of New Haven, Conn., are spending the summer at their old home in Bayside.

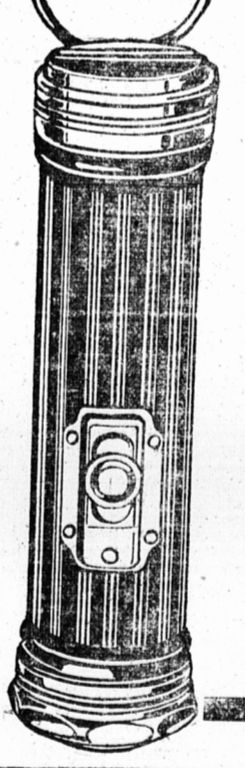
